Thursday Sept 19th Fresh breeze the first part of this day Employed in boiling & stowing down oil in after Hatch. Middle part fresh breeze heading to the N.W. Latter part finished boiling & ends fine weather. Stowing down oil

Sunday Sep^r 22^d 1861st Commences Moderate breeze and fine weather. Nothing in sight worthy of Remark aboard 1 bbl of Beef & 1 bbl of Fish. Middle and Latter part light breeze & Pleasant Employed in Building a new Bone Pen. & shifting the Bone on account of the decks heaving. Saw Kimbark

Sat by Obs 47.45 N. Long by Chs 150.10 E

Monday Sept 23^d Continues fine weather and light breeze 2 P.M. Saw R.W. & lowered 3 Boats. Eastern Boat got to the Whale & Pricked him & he rammed Sun St the Whale in sight. Middle part Moderate Latter part Strong breeze inclining to a gale Saw a R.W. going to Windward did not lower for him

Tuesday Sept 24th Commences with a young Gale from the Eastward. Sailing with close reefed M.S. & J. & J. sails. Middle part the same. Latter part more Moderate steering S.E. Saw nothing worthy of Remark

Wednesday Sept 25th Continues fresh breeze and rugged steering S.E. 4 P.M. luffed up South. Middle and Latter part light breeze & cloudy Saw Kimbark & Porpoise. Ends Cloudy
