Tuesday Oct 15th Continues fresh breeze Steering to S. E. S. Middle and Latter part the same. Saw a Strange Sail

Friday Oct 18th Continues Moderate breeze from the Southward heading to Windward & P.M. Spoke Barks Alice. Beabe. of Cold Spring. 1 Whale the season Middle part fresh breeze heading S. E. Latter part Squally with rain heading various ways at Meridian Wind from the N. N. E. Steering South

Saturday October 19th 1861. First part Strong breeze and Squally from N. N. E. Steering South and S. by W. Middle and Latter part light breeze heading for the most part of the time S. by W. Ends Inclining to a calm

Sunday Oct 20th Commenced light air & calm Middle and Latter part light baffling wind and Squally with Showers of rain. Saw 2 Strange Sails

Latt by Obs 26.00 N. Long by Chron 152.50 W

Monday Oct 21 Continues the same Middle and Latter part Squally with Showers of rain. Saw 2 Strange

Latt Obs 25.20 N. Long by Chron 153.10 W

Tuesday Oct 22th First part fresh breeze & Squally heading S. E. S. Middle part Wind Shifted in a Squall to the North Steered South. Latter part light breeze from N. N. E. Steering S. by W. Watches Employed Various

Wednesday Oct 23th Light breeze the first part of this day Steering South. Middle and Latter part light breeze and fine weather Steering S. by W.

Thursday Oct 24th Continues the same opened 1 bbl of Beef & found 1 bbl very bad & threw it overboard Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from N. E. Steering S. by W. Watches Employed in Various Jobs

Friday Oct 25th Fresh breeze Saw Island of Cypher Steering in for it. 3 Bells came to anchor in Bays Bay and furled the sails. 3 Ships in port. Florida of N. B. Barnstable of N. B. Fabius of N. B. full. Middle part Rainy. Latter part fine weather Washing Ship Inside. I shall not write any more while lying in port unless something happens besides the ordinary routine of work. that is usual on board Ships

Ends Oct 26.
