Monday Jan^y 20th Commenced moderate breeze heading to the Eastward. Middle part light air Latter part light breeze heading S.E. Capt. about the same

Wednesday Jan^y 29th continued moderate Steered W. N. W. Opened 2 bbl Pork & 1 of Beef filled 1 bbl Stuck. Middle and Latter part moderate & squally with showers of rain heading W. N. W.

Thursday Jan^y 30th These 24 hours continued the same. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze Steering W. by N. and W. N. W. Capt. about the same

Latt Obs 5.18 N.

Friday Jan^y 31st continued fresh breeze & squally at 1 Bell Saw Strong Island to the Westward Steered for it at 4 PM luffed by the wind for the night Middle part the same. Latter part kept off for the Island and passed all around it. No one came on board. Steering by the wind to N.W. S. ends. Capt. about the same

Saturday Feb^r 1st continued about the same Middle part Steered West. Latter part the same

Sunday Feb^r 2nd Fresh breeze first part Steering West 4 Bell Steered N.W. Middle part luffed by the wind. Latter part Steered N.W. by W.
