

Remarks On Board Of Ship Masenge Of New Bedford

Saturday May 3^d 1862. First part Moderate breeze and Cloudy. Employed in cutting up the blubber. 5 P.M. commenced boiling Middle and Latter part Moderate breeze heading to the westward, boiling

Tatt Obs 39.15 N Long by Obs 135.25 E

Sunday May 4th Moderate Breeze 2 P.M. finished boiling about 25 bbls. Middle part the same. Latter part Employed in coopersing the bit & stowing it back again in Main Hatch, heading to the westward

Tatt by Obs 39.10 N Long by Obs 134.25 E

Monday May 5th Fresh breeze Employed in stowing back the bit, heading to the W. by N. Middle and Latter part Strong breeze & Bledged heading to the W. by N. W. done nothing with the bit today.

Tuesday May 6th Continues fresh breeze heading to the W. by N. 5 P.M. heading to the westward wind to the Northward. Middle and Latter part light breeze and fine weather Employed in breaking out the bit, coopersing it and stowing it back again

Wednesday May 7th Commences light breeze heading West. Stowing down bit &c. Middle part the same. Latter part Raining, Storing West

Thursday May 8th Continues Rainy dirty weather Steering W. by N. Middle part Strong breeze and sunny. Latter part Moderate. Employed in coopersing bit and stowing it down. Ends Cloudy.

Friday May 9th First part Strong breeze, lying under close reef M. & S. sail. Middle part the same. Latter part light breeze, Steering West

Saturday May 10th 1862. Commences fresh breeze Steering W. by N. Middle part light air and foggy. Latter part Calm and foggy. Employed in breaking out in fore hold for hakey bit to Cooper. Ends Foggy

Sunday May 11th Moderate breeze, the first part of this day Employed in coopersing & stowing down. Wind from the Northward. Middle part fresh breeze. Steering aback. Latter part fine weather Employed in breaking out fore hold & coopersing bit to Ends

Monday May 12th Fine weather the first part of this day finished the bit in fore hold.

Middle & Latter part fine weather & gentle breeze heading in for the Land which is in sight ahead W. by N. W. Started 2 bbls Pork & 1 1/2 bbls Beef yesterday

Tatt Obs 39.56 N Long 129.03 E

Tuesday May 13th Finished stowing down the bit yesterday and find we have lost about 100 bbls. the weather continues fine. Employed in various jobs. Middle and Latter part light breeze and fine weather Steering along the land plenty of fish boats in sight. Pinbacks

Tatt Obs 40.18 N

Wednesday May 14th Continues fine weather Steering to the N. by E. Middle and Latter part light air and calm. Pinbacks, the Land & White Rock & any quantity of fish boats in sight.

Thursday May 15th The weather continues about the same. Middle and Latter part light breeze and smoky weather Saw Pinbacks Grampuses and the Land all along shore

Almost 8 months since we got a whale and about 130 bbls bit left than when we left the Ochotsk Sea in September last
