

Remarks on Board of Ship Manxago of New Bedford

Saturday May 31st 1862.. commencing moderate breezes and rainy. Middle part moderate. Latter part light breezes & clear weather steering along the land saw 16 humpbacks and lowered for them No. 40. So Ends
Land is

Sunday June 1st continuing fine weather saw many quantities of humpbacks. we are now where we saw plenty of whales last year. but no whales now. Middle and latter part moderate breezes beating to windward that is to the northward. Saw humpbacks & Land
Land is

Monday June 2nd moderate breezes & cloudy the first part of this day. Light breezes and calm the rest of this day. Humpbacks and the land in sight
Land is

Tuesday June 3rd continuing light air.
Middle and latter part the same heading to the northward. Land & humpbacks in sight
Land is

Wednesday June 4th same as the 2nd hours previous nothing worthy of remark.
Land is

Thursday June 5th light breezes the first part steering to the E. N. E. Broke out No. 1 bark 4th Middle and latter part light breezes heading N. E.
Land is

Friday June 6th continuing the same 3 P.M. saw a R. W. & lowered 3 boats but it was so little wind could not get fast Sun set took up the boats and steered to E. N. E. opened the Rig of Butler. While Middle part calm 4 AM saw R. W. lowered 3 boats and chased but could not get fast 8 O'clock took up the boats. Finbacks & the land in sight

Saturday June 7th 1862. Light breezes trying to get to the Eastward. Middle and latter part calm & foggy
Dogs is

Sunday June 8th continuing foggy with a light breeze heading to the E. N. E. Middle and latter part calm and calm. Ends same old story
Land is

Monday June 9th Light air heading E. N. E. Saw 2 strange sails at 5 P.M. saw a R. W. lowered 3 boats. Land boat darted but did not fasten he was too deep under water. Middle & latter part light air & foggy
Dogs is

Tuesday June 10th continuing light breezes & foggy heading to the Eastward. Middle part the same. Latter part light breezes and hazy smoky weather heading E. by N
Hazy is

Wednesday June 11th continuing the same opened 2 bbs Port. 1st & 2nd bbs. Middle and latter part fine breezes steering East. Cloudy hazy weather. Saw Finbacks
Smoking is

Thursday June 12th fine fresh breezes steering East. Middle part lay aback heading South latter part heading North thick fog. Ends foggy
Dogs, Dogs & Dogs. is

Friday June 13th commencing thick fog heading E. E. Middle part the same. 10 AM the fog lifted. Made sail and steered by the wind to the Westward saw Fin
Lat 42° 30' N. Long by Chron 137° 33' E.

Saturday June 14th commencing fresh breezes & smoky weather 3 P.M. saw R. W. and lowered 4 boats & chased (No go.) 7 took up boats. Clear weather through the night. Latter part thick fog inclining to a rain storm. Almost a month since we got a whale and the Lord only knows when we shall get one
I am almost discouraged of making much of a Season out. is
