

Remarks On Board Of Ship Moring Of No. 13.

Sunday June 15th 1862^d Continues Foggy & Rainy Middle and Latter part Strong breeze and Bugged Inclining to a gale. Clouds thick & dirty & Gale of Wind

Rainy
Monday June 16th Continues the same. Middle part Strong Gale & Bugged. Latter part more moderate and Cloudy Made some sail & Steered to W. N. W.

Latt 6^h 41.35 N Long by Chron 137.36 E

Tuesday June 17th Commenced Strong breeze and Cloudy Steering N. W. and North. 7 P.M. saw Whales turn fluky off the Lee. Moderate through the night 5.30 P.M. saw Whales lowered 3 boats could not catch C.W. & C.L. took up Boats. 9.30 lowered 3 boats again and chased no better luck. 12.30 took up boats.

Latt 6^h 42.27 N

Wednesday June 18th First part Moderate & Clear 3 P.M. came in Foggy heading by the Wind S. E. Middle and Latter fine weather and Gentle breeze Steering to the Westward. Nothing in sight.

Latt 6^h 42.33 N Long by Chron 135.50 E

Thursday June 19th Continues the same at 3 P.M. saw R. W. & lowered 4 boats. Starboard boat got to the Whale & pricked him with one Iron & he Deft his horn. Middle part being under Short sail heading to the S. E. Latter part some Fog in squally saw a dead Finback & took him along side and cut him in and commenced boiling. Suppose he is the one Capt. Shot some days ago. End Strong breeze & Smoakky

Friday June 20th Continues fresh breeze & Smoakky in boiling 8 P.M. finished about 15 boats heading to the W. N. W. Middle and Latter part Foggy

Tuesday June 24th First part light breeze & Rainy with thunder & lightning. Middle & Latter part thick dirty rainy weather heading various ways

Wednesday June 25th First part Moderate breeze and Cloudy thick weather heading to the N. W. Middle and Latter part Moderate breeze & thick weather lit up a little about 10 P.M. saw the Land

Land is

Thursday June 26th First part passing fog squally saw a three masted Schooner Steering to the S. E. and the Land (the Wood Land) to the N. W. of us Middle and Latter part Foggy heading to the S. E.

Fog is

Friday June 27th Continues Foggy. Middle part the same. Latter part Moderate breeze and passing fog squally heading to the N. W. saw nothing

Saturday June 28th First part Moderate and Cloudy heading N. W. 4 P.M. Steered N. by E. Middle and Latter part continual Foggy Fog is Fog

Sunday June 29th Commences Fog. Lying aback. Middle and Latter part the same Foggy Fog is

Fog. Thick is

Monday June 30th Continues the same. Middle part likewise. Latter part lit up saw the Land ahead heading N. W. 6 miles distance at Meridian
