

Remarks on Board of Ship *Manning* of *Northampton*

Monday August 4<sup>th</sup> 1852. Rain untill 2 P.M. lit up and started the fire. Saw R.W. but it came on foggy. Employed in boiling stowing down and setting up Shocks. Middle part steadily Latter part Rainy rigged in old sail over the stocks and kept on boiling and setting up Shocks.

Tuesday Aug 5<sup>th</sup> First part Clouds & strong breeze. Rained. 3 P.M. saw R.W. did not lower & employed in boiling &c. fresh breeze through the night. Latter part strong breeze & squally. Saw R.W. did not lower but went to stowing down. boiling &c.

Wednesday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> Continues strong breeze & Cloud stowing down. boiling & setting up Shocks. Moderate through the night. Latter part light breeze & pleasant finished boiling at 8.30. Saw R.W. lowered 4 boats and chased. Ends clearing.

Thursday Aug 7<sup>th</sup> fine weather 2.30 took up boats no fish took out for molasses. 12 bbls Beef 2 bbls Pork 5.50 saw R.W. lowered 4 boats. no go. 7.30 took up boats moderate through the night. 5 A.M. saw R.W. lowered 4 boats & chased. no go. 7.30 took up boats. saw more R.W. lowered again. Carpent boat struck fast to the whale at meridian.



Friday Aug 8<sup>th</sup> Fine weather fast to the whale at 10.00 took him along side & took in side. Light breeze the balance of the night. at 7 A.M. commenced cutting. keep setting up shocks. cutting the rest of the day. Saw Pinback.

Henry Etchidge Master *Ocholsk Sea*

Saturday August 9<sup>th</sup> 1852. Fine weather & gentle breeze 3 P.M. finished cutting & commenced boiling. middle and latter part moderate employed in heating out. boiling and setting up Shocks. Saw Pinback.

Sunday Aug 10<sup>th</sup> Continues moderate from S.E. stowing down & boiling saw Humphrey & middle and latter part moderate and clouds employed in boiling and setting up Shocks. Saw no Whales to day.

Monday Aug 11<sup>th</sup> Continues moderate breeze and squally steering to the N.E. boiling &c. middle part fresh breeze finished boiling. Latter part strong breeze & rigged. Saw Humphrey. stowing down.

Tuesday Aug 12<sup>th</sup> strong breeze inclining to a gale from N.E. took in all sail but storm sails. middle part strong breeze and some rain. Latter part moderated a little. very breezy 3 years out to day with 2500 bbls oil. Ends clearing but more moderate.

Wednesday Aug 13<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breeze and quite ruffled setting up Shocks 4 P.M. made sail and stowed S.E.W. middle part clear & pleasant. Latter part Rainy & foggy. employed setting up Shocks.

Thursday Aug 14<sup>th</sup> Continues Rainy & foggy heading to the S.W. middle and latter part light breeze and fog. stowing down &c. saw Pinbacks.

Friday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> Foggy. stowing down &c. middle and latter part the same heading by the wind on different tacks under short sail. Fog or Fogie.
