

Remarks on Board of Ship Maringo of New Bedford

Friday Aug 29th 1860. Continues strong breezy & fog. Finished stowing for the night. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breezy & pleasant. Saw any quantity of Finback. Employed in boiling.

Latt Obs 47° 15' N. Long by Chro 147° 03' E

Saturday Aug 31st. Fine weather and moderate breezy. Weather N. E. & P. M. Saw R. W. Lowered Harbor Boat got smashed, pretty bad, but did not get fast to the whale. Took her in. Middle and Latter part fresh breezy & smoky with showers of rain. Put the S. Boat on Harbor Crane & put an old boat on Starboard crane, & the Stove boat overboard. Saw R. W. Lowered & Chased but no go. Took up boat.

Rainy

Sunday Aug 31st. Continues Rainy dirty weather. Fitting the boats. V. R. Middle part Ch. Latter part Foggy. Stowing Water & R. below deck.

Fog is Fog. Long 147° 38' E

Monday September 1st. Continues Foggy. 3 P. M. let up made sail & steered N. E. finished stowing Water. Middle and Latter part. Rain. Fog and Cloudy. Heading to the Eastward. Saw Planty Finback.

No Obs. Long by Chro 148° 16' E

Tuesday Sept 2^d. First part cloudy and fresh breezy. E. S. E. Middle and Latter part. Cloudy and some fog heading various ways. Saw Finback.

Latt by Obs 47° 30' N. Long by Chro 147° 35' E

Wednesday Sept 3^d. First part cloudy & smoky 2^d. Saw R. W. Lowered, Harbor Boat struck. Flitter and sunk. parted the line & lost about 5 shot of line. Middle and Latter part S. breezy and rugged 3 A. M. Saw R. W. Lowered the boat, and Chased the rest of this day but could not catch one. Meridian look up boats.

Latt Obs 47° 11' N. Long by Chro 148°

Remarks on Board of Ship Maringo of New Bedford

Friday August 31st 1860. Strong breezy & dirty weather the first part of this day. Middle and Latter part fresh breezy & foggy. Employed in boiling. No Obs.

Saturday September 1st. Continues moderate breezy & thick fog. Middle part the same finished boiling. Latter part moderate breezy and fine weather. Employed in breaking out fore hold to stow down. Saw Finback. 6 bbls filled one bbl & lusk.

Latt by Obs 47° 49' N. Long by Chro 146° 26' E

Sunday Sept 2^d. Moderate breezy and cloudy weather. Stowing down bit. Middle part finished. Latter part Saw R. W. lowered but could not get fast came on board and stowed off fore hold. No Obs.

Monday Sept 3^d. Light breezy & light fog squally. 12.30 lowered for R. W.

Harbor Boat struck. 2.30 took to the ship and commenced cutting. took in throat, lip & head and lashed for the night. Saw 1 strange sail. Middle part moderate. Latter part fine weather & gentle breezy 9 A. M. finished cutting & made sail. No Obs.

Latt by Obs 47° 27' N. Long by Chro 147° 03' E

Tuesday Sept 4th. Continues fine weather commenced boiling 2 P. M. wait R. W. lowered and chased could not get fast. Middle and Latter part light breezy. Skated 1 bbl & 1 bbl. Spoke the Gustave of 46 years 22 months. Out 1100 bbls sold the Capt. 1 box of Tobacco. Ends calm & cloudy. Employed in boiling. Saw No Whales to day. No Obs.
