

Remarks on Board of Ship *Marango* of New Bedford.

Wednesday September 5th 1862. Continues
Calm & cloudy. Middle part foggy. Latter part
light air and cloudy. Saw Finbacks & 1 Ship
Employed in boiling. So Ends this day
No Obs

Thursday Sept 6th. First part light breezy &
cloudy weather. Middle part the same finished
boiling. Latter part light breezy & foggy with rain
at intervals. Employed in Stowing oil in the
Main Hatch. Saw the Omega. No Exits.

Latt 47. 55 N. Long 147. 45 E

Friday Sept 7th. First part foggy Stowed off
Main Hatch. Middle part much the same.
Latter part thick fog. Stowing down oil F. Hatch
No Obs

Saturday Sept 8th. Continues thick fog
finished Stowing oil Middle part rain.
Latter part strong gale from W. W. and ending
No Obs

Sunday Sept 9th. Continues much the
same. Middle & Latter part strong breezy and
hazy weather. Saw a Ship Boiling in

Monday Sept 10th. Strong breezy and quite
rugged. Saw No Whales for 5 or 6 days. Middle
and Latter part light breezy with some rain
and thick fog. Employed in cleaning Bona
No Obs

Tuesday Sept 11th. Light breezy and foggy
finished the bone the first part of this day.
Middle part the same. Latter part moderate
breezy from the Eastward. Saw a R. W. lowered
for him but could not get fast. rather shy
Saw finbacks. So Ends R. W. in sight.

Henry Eldredge Master. Ochotsk Sea

Thursday September 4th 1862. Spent 1 Part of Hour
Rather more moderate
Saw R. W. Lowered but could not get to line. 3 P.M.
took up boat. Middle & Latter part Calm. Saw R. W. did
not lower.

Latt Obs 47. 21 N. Long by Chron 147. 10 E

Friday Sept 5th. First part light air at 12.30 Lowered
for R. W. Saw boat Boat Struck L. B.
& Killed 3.30 took him aboard
Side and commenced cutting
took in the Head gear and



Lashed down for the night. at 7 P.M. found 1 1/2 bbls. Beef and
1 bbl Pork. Moderate through the night. 4 AM commenced
cutting 8.30 finished & made sail heading to the Westward

Latt Obs 47. 20 N. Long by Chron 148. 14 E

Saturday Sept 6th. Fresh breezy first part Saw R. W.
Lowered 3 boats called and came on board. Employed
in boiling. Middle part fresh breezy. Latter part the same
heading various ways. Saw nothing. boiling & setting up. Hatch

Latt Obs 47. 15 N. Long by Chron 148. 23 E

Sunday Sept 7th. Continues fine weather. Saw Finbacks
Middle part the same. Latter part Foggy. finished boiling
and Stowed off. Fore Hold. Ends Foggy. 1 Keg H. Sugar.
Foggy in Foggy.

Monday Sept 8th. Continues Foggy. Middle and Latter
part light breezy and Foggy. Employed in Stowing
down oil in left Hatch. Stowed off the Hold with
oil. securing room for a little provision. Lower Hold
full of oil all but about 50 bbls. & about 100 bbls in the
Parks. Ends Foggy

Tuesday Sept 9th. Commences Foggy & Calm
Middle part the same. Latter part light air and
Cloudy. Saw R. W. Lowered but it was no go
Cloudy

Wednesday Sept 10th. First part light breezy Stowing
to S. E. Saw Finbacks. Middle part Calm. Latter part
fresh breezy. Saw R. W. to Windward did not lower.
