

Remarks on Board of Ship Marango of New Bedford

Wednesday September 24th 1862. First part fresh breeze from the Southward Steering East finished Stove boat and put her overboard. Middle and latter part fresh breeze and Foggy & Rainy. Steering E. by N.

Thursday Sept 25th continues Foggy. The best old Mainwale & bent the best one. and various other jobs Steering E. by N. Middle & latter part moderate Steering East. Lat 47. 00 N. Long 166. 40 E

Friday Sept 26th continues moderate Steering East Middle part moderate from S. E. Steering E. by N. Latter part light breeze heading N. E. Ends Rainy & Calm Rainy.

Saturday Sept 27th commences light breeze & Showers heading various ways. Middle and latter part fresh breeze and Cloudy from W. S. W. Steering East, all sail set Lat 47. 04 N Long by Chron 166. 38 E

Sunday Sept 28th continues strong breeze Steering East Middle part moderate. Latter part light breeze Steering E. by N. Lat 46. 25 N. Long by Chron 158. 50 E

Monday Sept 29th Light baffling wind heading to the Eastward. Middle and latter part moderate breeze heading to the N. E. Employed in various jobs in Lat 47. 12 N

Tuesday Sept 30th continues moderate breeze heading to the N. E. by the Wind. Middle and latter part much the same only Rainy and Foggy. Lat 46. 30 N Long by Chron 174. 50 E

Wednesday October 1st continues the same Middle part fresh breeze Steering E. by S. Latter part strong breeze & Rugged from S. W. Steering E. by S. Lat 46. 30 N Long by Chron 174. 50 E

Thursday October 2nd continues strong breeze from S. W. Steering E. by S. Middle and latter part moderate breeze Steering E. by S. S. Employed in cleaning Bone Lat 45. 33 N. Long by Chron 178. 58 E

Friday Oct 3rd continues moderate breeze from S. W. Steering E. S. E. Middle and latter part strong breeze and Rainy from S. E. Steering by the Wind Lat 44. 30 N. Long by Chron 176. 45 W

Saturday Oct 4th continues about the same Middle and latter part strong breeze and Rugged Steering E. S. E. East and E. N. E. So Ends Lat 44. 30 N. Long by Chron 176. 45 W

Sunday Oct 5th commences rather more moderate Steering E. S. E. Opened 1 cask of Flour 3 1/2 bbls Middle and latter part moderate breeze heading to the Eastward. bent a new pit. Employed variously Lat 43. 45 N

Monday Oct 6th Light breeze the first part of this day and Cloudy weather Steering E. by S. Middle part light breeze Steering E. S. E. Latter part fresh breeze from the N. N. E. & Rainy Steering E. by E. Lat 41. 30 N

Tuesday Oct 7th continues strong breeze and a heavy swell from N. N. E. Steering E. S. E. Middle part light air and Calm. Latter part strong breeze from the Westward Steering E. S. E. Opened 1 box of Tea. Fitting tiller blocks &c &c &c Lat 40. 00 N Long by Chron 169. 05 W

Wednesday Oct 8th strong breeze the first part of this day from the W. W. W. Steering E. S. E. Employed in scraping bone. Middle and latter part moderate breeze Steering E. S. E. Scraping bone Lat 38. 14 N. Long 166. 50 W

Thursday Oct 9th commences light breeze from the Westward Steering E. S. E. Washing bone Middle part Calm Latter part light breeze from the South Steering E by S. by the Wind Employed in washing and drying bone Lat 37. 25 N. Long 165. 33 W
