Thursday May 10th

This Day begins with strong winds from N.W. and pleasant weather. At 3 P.M. the Boat came from the shore At 4 P.M. made all sail and steered South At 7 P.M. St Jago Bore N by W. Dist 6 leagues. Middle and Latter parts light winds and pleasant weather. Ship under all sail steering Sth. Nothing in sight remarkable So ends this Days work. Lat Obs. 12. 15 N.

Friday May 11th

This Day begins with light winds from N.W. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts, winds and weather much the same as the first At 3. h 55 m. in the morning, there was a very bright comet its nose from the horizon to the west and set in the Eastern horizon. N. 33. Ship under all sail. Clearing S by E. Nothing in sight remarkable So ends. Lat Obs. 10. 10 N.

Saturday May 12th

Band of Bright Star This Day begins with light winds from N.W. and pleasant weather. At 2 P.M. saw a sail steering S. E. Middle and Latter parts light winds and pleasant. So ends Lat Obs. 9. 15 N.

Sunday May 13th

This Day begins with light winds from N.W. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts, winds and weather much the same as the first. Ship under all sail steering S by E. Nothing in sight remarkable. So ends this Days work. all hands on Board well. Lat Obs. 8. 44 N.

Monday May 14th

This Day begins with light winds from N.W. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts winds the same as the first, with squalls of rain. Ship under all sail. So ends Lat Obs. 7. 55 N.

Tuesday May 15th

Band of Flour This Day begins with light winds from N.W. and thick rainy weather. Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first. One sail in sight. Ship under all sail. Clearing S by E. So ends this Day. All hands on Board well. Lat Obs.

Wednesday May 16th

This Day begins with light winds from N.W. to Sth. and squally weather. Middle and Latter parts light winds and pleasant. At 11 P.M. saw a school of Black Fish, but did not come for them. So ends the Day. Lat Obs. 5. 25 N.

Thursday May 17th

This Day begins with light winds from the South and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts Calm and rain squalls. Nothing in sight remarkable So ends. Lat Obs. 4. 56 N.

Friday May 18th

Cook of Bread This Day begins with a calm and squalls of rain. Middle and Latter parts calm and pleasant. Nothing in sight remarkable. This Day. So ends

Lat Obs. 3. 15 N.
