Saturday May 19th
 This Day begins with calm and pleasant weather Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first Nothing in sight remarkable This day
 So ends Lt Vls 5.10 N.

Sunday May 20th
 This Day begins with calm and pleasant weather Middle parts the same as the first Latter parts light winds from E.S.E. and squally at 11 A.M. set the studdsails Nothing in sight remarkable
 So ends the Day Lt Vls 5.14 N.

Monday May 21st
 This Day begins with light winds from East S.W. and squally at 3 P.M. split the Fore Top sail in a squall on board it and bent another Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first
 So ends the day Lt Vls.

Tuesday May 22d
 This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and squally weather Middle and Latter parts light wind and thick rainy weather So ends Lt Vls.

Wednesday May 23d
 This Day begins with light winds and variable with thick rainy weather Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first At 10 A.M. took in the Fore Gallant Sails At 11 A.M. set them again Nothing in sight remarkable So ends the Day
 Lt Vls.

New Brunswick Outward Bound 1839

Thursday May 24th
 This Day begins with light winds from E.S.E. and squally rain Middle and Latter parts light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather Nothing in sight remarkable Ship under all sail that is required by the wind So ends Lt Vls 3.59 N.

Friday May 25th
 This Day begins with strong winds from S.W. and flying clouds Middle and Latter parts strong winds and pleasant weather The watch employed in mending sails Nothing in sight Ship under all sail That is required by the wind So ends the Days work Lt by Vls 2.50 N.

Saturday May 26th
 This Day begins with strong winds from S.W. and pleasant weather Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first The watch employed in mending sails, one sail in sight So ends the day Lt Vls 1.44 N.

Sunday May 27th
 This Day begins with strong winds from S.W. and pleasant weather Middle and Latter parts light winds from E.S.E. and pleasant weather So ends this Day Lt Vls 11.00

Monday May 28th
 This Day begins with light winds from E.S.E. and pleasant weather Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first Nothing in sight So ends the Day Lt Vls 13 N.
