Sunday May 29th

Barrel of. This Day begins with light winds from E. S. E. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first. So ends Lt. Vls. 3. 27 S.

Monday May 30th

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts the same. Nothing in sight. remarkable. So ends this Days work. Lt. Vls. 3. 31 S.

Tuesday May 31st

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and squalls of rain. At 5 P.M. sent down the Main Royal yard and on rose the rigging. Middle and Latter parts strong winds and squally weather. One sail in sight. Ship under all sail that is required by the wind. So ends the Day, all hands well. Lt. Vls. 7. 40 S.

Friday June 1st

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and squally weather. Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first. Nothing in sight. remarkable. So ends this Day. Lt. Vls. 9. 16 S.

Saturday June 2^d

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts strong winds and squally. Nothing in sight. So ends. Lt. Vls. 11. 11 South.

New Brunswick Outward, Bound 1832.

Sunday June 3^d

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and squally weather. Middle and Latter parts the same as the first. Ship under all sail that is required by the wind. So ends Lt. 13. 05 S.

Monday June 4th

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts the same as the first. At 5 A.M. took in the Fore Gallant sail. So ends the Day. Lt. Vls. 16. 12 S.

Tuesday June 5th

This Day begins with strong winds from S. E. and flying clouds. At 2 P.M. set the Fore Gallant sail. Middle and Latter parts strong Gale from S. E. and squally. At 2 A.M. took in the Fore Gallant Sails Fore and aft. So ends. Lt. Vls. 17. 04 S.

Wednesday June 6th

Barrel of. This Day begins with strong Gale from S. E. and flying clouds. Middle and Latter much the same as the first. At 7 A.M. sent down the Fore and Main Fore Gallant yards and filled them. Saw a number of Fin Back whale. So ends this Days work. Lt. Vls. 19. 12 S.

Thursday June 7th

This Day begins with strong Gale from S. E. and heavy weather and squally. Middle and Latter parts much the same as the first. Saw a number of Fin Back whale. So ends Lt. Vls. 21. 01 S.
