Wednesday July 4th

Capt. of. This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and
Broad. pleasant weather. The watch employed in Ships Duty.
Middle and Latter part light winds from S.W. and
hazy weather. Ship under all sail that is required by
the wind. Nothing in sight remarkable. So ends the Day.
Long by Chron. 10.07 M. L.H. Ob. 37.02 S.

Thursday July 5th

This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and
and hazy weather. Middle and Latter parts pleasant
weather. At 7 A.M. made the Island of Tristan da
Cunha, bearing S.W. Dist. 26 Leagues. Saw a number
of Fin Back whale and Black Fish. At 10 A.M. sent
down the Jure Top. Guller's mast, and on rose the rigging.
So ends. Long by Chron. 10.44 M. L.H. Ob. 37.35 S.

Friday July 6th

Quaker of Butts. This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and
pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts strong
Gale from S.W. and thick weather. So ends L.H. Ob.

Saturday July 7th

This Day begins with strong Gale from S.W. and thick
weather with a heavy sea on Middle and Latter parts light
winds and hazy weather. Nothing in sight remarkable.
So ends this Days work. L.H. Ob.

Sunday July 8th

This day begins with light winds from S.W. and hazy
weather. Middle and Latter parts wind and weather much
the same as the first. Tristan da Cunha bore S.W. Dist.
16 leagues. So ends this Day L.H. Ob. 36.28 S.

Monday July 9th

This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and
hazy weather. Middle and Latter parts strong Gale
from S.W. and hazy weather. Tristan da Cunha
bore S.W. Dist. 8 leagues. Nothing in sight remarkable
except the Island. So ends L.H. Ob. 37.12 S.

Tuesday July 10th

This Day begins with strong Gale from S.W. and
and hazy weather. At 2 P.M. sighted the Jure Top
which on last it and sent another and bent a new
Main Course. Middle and Latter parts wind and weather
much the same as the first. Nothing in sight rem-
arkable. So ends the Day L.H. Ob. 36.58 S.

Wednesday July 11th

This Day begins with strong Gale from S.W. and
sunny weather. Middle and Latter parts light winds and
pleasant. At 8 A.M. went a shore on the Island of Tristan da
Cunha after potatoes. Saw one white whale. Saw sail in sig-
ht. So ends. The boats whaling along shore.

Thursday July 12th

Barrel of. This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and
pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts strong
Gale and thick weather. The Islands in sight.
So ends bying too on a Gale of wind.

Friday July 13th

This Day begins with strong gale from S.W. and
thick squally weather. Middle and Latter parts light
winds and thick weather. The Islands in sight.
So ends this Days work.
