Barnet of. This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts light winds from S.E. and pleasant. Ship under all sail steering S.W. Pike match employed in cutting down rigging. So ends.

Tuesday March 12th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts much the same as the first. At 9 A.M. Long by Lines Ob. 12.31.11. Ship under all sail steering S.W. So ends.

Wednesday March 13th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts light winds from S.E. and pleasant. At 10 A.M. Long by Lines Ob. 14.01.11. Ship under all sail steering S.W. So ends Long by Chron. 14.34.11. L.H. Ob. 9.38.5.

Thursday March 14th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts the same. At 10 A.M. Long by Lines Ob. 15.25.11. Ship under all sail steering S.W. So ends Long by Chron. 16.03.11. L.H. Ob. 8.14.5.

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. The match employed painting ship. Latter parts light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Ship under all sail steering S.W. Employed in painting ship. So ends L.H. Ob. 5.57.5.

Saturday March 16th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. At 5 A.M. ran a rail to southward of us heading to northward and not toward. Latter parts much the same as the first. At 10 A.M. Long by Lines Ob. 18.19.11. Ship under all sail steering S.W. employed in painting ship. So ends Long by Chron. 18.43.11. L.H. Ob. 5.53.5.

Sunday March 17th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts winds and weather much the same as the first. At 10 A.M. Long by Lines Ob. 19.20.11. Ship under all sail steering S.W. So ends Long by Chron. 19.43.11. L.H. Ob. 4.58.5.

Monday March 18th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts winds and weather much the same as the first. At 6 A.M. lost a new Main Top Gallant sail. Ship under all sail steering S.W. Nothing in sight remarkable. So ends The Day. 1. mark.
