

Journal of the Barque Margaret St. John

Sunday April 7th

This Day begins with light winds from N.E. and pleasant weather. Latter parts much the same as the first. One sail in sight steering S.W. Ship under all sail steering N.W. So ends.
Long by Chron. 49.30 W. Lat 18.29 N.

Monday April 8th

This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and pleasant weather. Latter parts calm. Saw great quantities of gulf weed. So ends Lat Ob. 19.10 N.

Tuesday April 9th

This Day begins with light winds from W.S.W. and pleasant weather. Latter parts winds and weather much the same as the first. Ship under all sail heading N.W. That is required by the wind. So ends Lat Ob. 20.12 N.

Wednesday April 10th

This Day begins with calm and clear weather. Latter parts the same. So ends Long by Chron. 49.51 W. Long by Chron. 49.55 W. Lat Ob. 19.55 N.

Thursday April 11th

This Day begins with a calm and pleasant weather. Latter parts light winds from S.E. and pleasant weather. Ship under all sail steering N.W. So ends At 9 A.M. Long by Chron. 50.52 W. Long by Chron. 50.41 W. Lat Ob. 20.54 N.

A.B. Bound to St. John New Brunswick 1833.

Friday April 12th

Barque of B. & P. J. K. This Day begins with light winds from S.E.W. and pleasant. At 7 P.M. cloudy with lightning. Latter parts thick squally weather with heavy tempests of thunder and lightning. At 8 A.M. saw a Brig to the S.W. then and westward. Took in sail & made sail as occasion requires. So ends. At Ob.

Saturday April 13th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. and cloudy weather. Latter parts light wind and variable, with heavy tempest and rain. So ends. At Ob.

Sunday April 14th

This Day begins with light winds and variable with squalls of wind and rain. Latter parts light winds from S.E. and squally weather. Ship under such sail as is required by the weather steering N.W. So ends. At Ob.

Monday April 15th

This Day begins with light winds from S.E. to S.W. and squally weather. Latter parts calm and pleasant. So ends At Ob. Long by Chron. 50.55 W. Long by Chron. 50.55 W. Lat Ob. 21.10 N.

Tuesday April 16th

This Day begins with light winds from N.E. and hazy weather. Latter parts parts parts strong winds from S.W. and pleasant weather. Ship under all sail steering N.W. So ends. Long by Chron. 51.47 W. Lat Ob. 21.10 N.
