

Journal of the Barque Marguerite of St John & B.

Friday May 3.

This Day begins with strong winds from W. S. W. to S. W. and moorish weather. At 3 o'clock conveyed away the Bone Pap Gallant studdsail boom. At 6 o'clock reported a fishing Schooner from the Isle of Hott. Got the Bearings and Dist of Mount Desert. At 10 o'clock Dist 5 leagues. Dried up on the wind. Latter part strong Gale from S. W. and clear weather. At 12 or mid night double reefed the Pap Sails & took in the Jib. At 1 o'clock winds from S. W. made all sail and started M. C. G. At 12 Mount Desert bore W. S. W. Dist 8 leagues. So ends

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Saturday May 4th

Plus Day begins with light winds from W. Wind
pleasant weather. At 3 P.M. spoke a pilot Boat from
St. Andrew's a number of sail in sight. At 7 P.M.
Nora took light Bore N by W. Dist 4 leagues, and Seal
Islands light. Bore W. Dist 5 leagues, and Selby Islands
light bore W. N. E. Dist 3 leagues from 10 P.M. till 10 P.M.
calm, and then a light breeze from S by Ship under
all sail steering E. N. E. So ends

Sunday May 5th

This Day begins with light winds from S.W. and pleasant weather. At 3 P.M. took a pilot of Point Barrow. At 5 P.M. barage Island light bore N.W. & Dist 5 miles. At 10 P.M. let go anchor of Barage Island. Latter parts light winds from S.W. and pleasant weather. At 7 A.M. weighed anchor and ran up. At 11 A.M. let go anchor in St. John Harbor.
