Saturday
October
3^d 1835

This 24 hours commences with gentle
B. breeze from S. star. S. by E. hands
Employed in ships duty all the middle
and latter part light winds and
calms To ends this 24 hours latter 17° 58' S Long 30° 28' W

Sunday
October
4th 1835

Commences with the same kind of
weather as on 3^d light breeze from S. star
To the eastward of us steaming to the South
continued so all the middle and
latter ends latter 18° 31' S Long 30° 45' W

Monday
October
5th 1835

This 24 hours commences with gentle
breeze from S. and baffin continue our
Course to the S.W. all the middle and
latter parts fine weather Brooke out
The fore side the fore hole and
coopered the dry provisions To ends
Latitude 19° 56' S Longitude 31° 00' W

Tuesday
October
6th 1835

Commences with fine weather light
winds and calms Brooke out the
Star side the fore hole and coopered
The dry provisions middle part 40° S. cere
To the North Star S. by E. broke out between
Decks To ends latter 20° 21' S Long 29° 30' W

Wednesday
October
7th 1835

Commences with fine weather and gentle
breeze from N. course S. hands employed
In breaking out all the middle and latter
The same To ends latter 22° 38' S Long 29° 16' W

Thursday
October
8th

Commences with strong breeze from N. course S.
hands employed in breaking over potatoes middle
and smaller rain latter part fine weather
To ends latter 24° 40' S Longitude 29° 10' W

9th 1835

and light breeze from S. by E. hands
Ships duty at 6 pm Star 2 large thin
Ducks all the middle part calm
latter part gentle breeze from S. course
S. by E. To ends latter 23° 45' S Long 29° 00' W

October
10th 1835

Commences with gentle breeze from
S. by E. course S. by E. hands employed in
ships duty To watch employed in ships duty
all the middle and latter part fine
weather To ends latter 24° 52' S Long 30° 00' W

Sunday
October
11th 1835

Commences with strong winds from
S. course S. by E. hands employed in ships
duty Saw fin backs and cold throat
Sperm whales all the middle and
latter parts strong breeze from
N. by E. To ends latter 26° 48' S Long 29° 20' W

Monday
October
12th 1835

Commences with strong winds from
N. by E. course S. by E. hands employed in
ships duty all the middle
and latter parts fine weather but
strong gales from N. by E. at 10 pm fine time
We star-waste boat and painted pen
To ends latter 28° 34' S Longitude 29° 10' W

Tuesday
October
13th 1835

This 24 hours commenced with strong
breeze from N.W. course S. by E. hands
employed in ships duty at 8 pm
Raid up 1 point more to the S. by E.
all the middle and latter parts
strong gales and rainy weather
To ends latter 30° 11' S Long 25° 00' W

Wednesday
October
14th 1835

Commences with strong gales from
N. by E. thick rain weather all the middle
and latter part fine weather painted the
fore hatch boat and got up the cruising fore
topmast To ends latter 31° 8' S Long 22° 50' W
