October
26th
1835

Cruising Off the islands

Commenced with fine weather
and gentle breeze from E after
dinner board again and chased
at sunset came on board and
sail and say to all the middle
and latter part strong gales from
the N. W. & W. all round but could
not get him 2 ships in sight
End Lat 37° 20' S Long 135° 45' W

Monday
October
26th
1835

Commenced with strong
gales from N took in all sail
and lay to and spencers and fore
staysel head to W. N. W. all the mid
dle and latter part the same so ends
Lat 37° 08' S Long 135° 20' W

Tuesday
October
27th
1835

Commenced with moderate gales
from W and fine weather but a heavy
well made all sail at 2 pm and
at 5 pm took all in but 6 main
topsail foresail & staysails all the
middle and latter part fine weather
with by swell saw the islands
so ends Lat 37° 04' S Long 135° 15' W

Wednesday
October
28th
1835

This 24 hours commenced with
fine weather and gentle breezes
from E & starboard upon the lar
jack all hands employed in ships duty
at 4 pm took in all but double
top sails latter part strong
winds so ends latitude 37° 05' S

Thursday
October
29th
1835

Commenced with a gale from
N. W. at 4 pm took in all sail
but a close reef main topsail and
staysels at 5 pm were under way
headed to the N. W. all the middle
and latter part strong winds from E star
board at 4 pm saw the islands so ends
Lat 37° 10' S Long 135° 10' W

Friday
October
30th
1835

Cruising Round the isls

This 24 hours commenced with
strong winds from N. W. star
board at 4 pm passed the isls
and all going quick
all the middle and latter part fine
weather and strong winds from the
East & North East so ends Lat 37° 05' S
Long 135° 10' W

Saturday
October
31st
1835

Commenced with fine weather from
N. W. came aboard and employed
in ships duty at 8 pm took in
top sails all the middle and
latter part fine weather strong
breeze out the main pole at 10 pm
up water so ends latitude 37° 05' S Long 135° 10' W

Sunday
October
31st
1835

Commenced with fine weather fine
breeze at 4 pm starboard at 4 pm saw
the islands but the sun set before
came on board all the middle and
latter part fine weather spoke 2 whales
at 10 pm so ends Lat 37° 05' S Long 135° 10' W

Monday
November
1st
1835

Commenced with strong winds from
N. W. at 4 pm saw 2 whales
but they were so far to windward that
we could not get up to them all the
middle and latter part fine weather saw 2 whales
latter part strong winds so ends this 24 hours
Lat 37° 05' S Long 135° 10' W

Tuesday
November
2nd
1835

Commenced with fine weather and
starboard at 4 pm saw 2 humpbacks
came aboard but could not catch them
at 7 pm took in the topsails all the middle
and latter part strong winds and
saw 2 whales steamed for them
Nothing more so ends latitude
37° 05' S Long 135° 10' W
