Decem^r the
13th 1835

Cruising For Whales

This 24 hours commenced with strong
Gales from the W with squally weather.
And at 4 pm saw 2 hump
backs with more moderate weather.
And later parts strong and
diff sea. Flogged 2 men for fighting
at ends latt 37° 45' S Long 6° 40' E

Monday
Decem^r
the 14th
1835

Commences with strong winds
from the W & S by East N W at
4 pm saw hump backs heavy sea
going all the middle and latter
parts fine weather and heavy sea
So ends this 24 hours latt 35° 55' S
Longitude 8° 05' E

Tuesday
Decem^r the
15th 1835

This 24 hours commenced with fine
Breeze from W & W steam at 11 with
sails out at 2 pm saw
2 hump backs land for them but
could not catch them saw 2 sails
at 4 pm of them bearing down for
us with sternsails out. Spoke the
Arab of Genoa bound to Laredo at
10 pm saw 4 whales land and got
back him alongside at ends latt
latt 37° 00' S Longitude

Wednesday
Decem^r the
16th
1835

Commences with fine weather
at 3 pm hoisted on at 5 pm hump
backs in at 6 pm shortening
sail for the watch middle and latter
parts fine weather at 6 am saw the
board and struck and at 11 am
along side flaked him and 8 c
at 12 pm more this 24 hours ends
latt 37° 00' S Longitude 7° 50' E

Sunday
Decem^r
the 17th
1835

Cruising For Whales

This 24 hours commenced with fine
weather light breeze from W at 12 m
Commenced cutting at 3 pm finished
beginning boiling again at 6 pm 2 hump
backs at the watch all the middle
and latter parts fine weather all continued
Boiling So ends latt 35° 55' S Longitude 8° 00' E

Friday Decem^r
the 18th
1835

This 24 hours commenced with fine weather
Continue boiling at 2 pm saw whale
going quick land but to no success
at 4 pm saw 2 or 3 more close by with
Continue fine continue boiling saw
a ship standing to the N & E all the middle
and latter parts fine weather finished
Boiling So ends latt 35° 55' S Longitude 8° 00' E

Saturday
the 19th
1835

This 24 hours commenced with fine weather
Wind about W & W steam to the land
One watch employed in scraping bone
at 2 pm saw 2 hump backs at 4 pm land
and chased till sunset to no success
all the middle and latter parts fine
weather at daylight commenced boiling
saw 2 whales land and chased to no
success So ends latt 35° 55' S Longitude 8° 00' E

Sunday
Decem^r 20th
1835

This 24 hours commenced with fine
weather continue stirring down saw large
Numbers of hump & fin backs at 5
pm finished stirring down 120 bls of
oil and clear the decks &c all the middle
and latter parts fine weather at 2 pm
So ends latt 35° 55' S Longitude 7° 12' E

Monday
Decem^r 21st
1835

Commences with gentle breeze from N & N
W by S at 11 of a note occurred the first
part at 7 pm shortened sail tacked to the N & E
at the middle part fine weather later
strong breeze high haze and rain at
10 pm saw a whale land for him but
the ship sailed him without more
So ends latt 35° 55' S Long 7° 45' E
