Commenced with light airs from
S.E. cross N.W. at 1 pm became
breezy with rain &c. Continued
to the end of the day
Latitude 15° 32' N Long 50° 32' W

Commenced with calms and light
airs from the S.E. star to N.W. N
Hands employed in ships duty &c.
At the middle part calm again
At 11 pm then took a squall from
S.E. with rain to end of the day
Latitude 16° 32' N Long 50° 32' W

Commenced with fine breeze from
S.E. with rain At 4 pm calm At
8 pm took a breeze from S.E. with rain
At 2 pm took the wind from N.W.
Continued all the latter part to end
Latitude 17° 40' N Long 50° 14' W

Commenced with strong breezes
from N.E. cross N.W. at 4 pm
Hands employed in ships duty &c.
All the middle and latter part
Equally with wind light at intervals
To end of the day

Commenced with fine weather and
breezy trades cross N.W. hands employed
in ships duty &c. All the middle

Commenced with strong trades
cross N.W. hands employed in ships
duty &c. a fine steady breeze from
N.W. till 2 pm became squally from
N. latter part calm to end of the
day Latitude 23° 05' N Long 50° 30' W

April 8 1837
42 S
Commenced with calms and light
airs from S.E. cross N.W. hands employed
in ships duty At 4 pm took the
wind from N.E. all the middle
and latter parts strong breezes
Hands employed in ships duty
to end Latitude 24° 17' N Long 50° 57' W
