and gentle breeze from N.W. star
at 10 AM. At 1 PM. the fore tack
was employed in bending the
spanker &c. All the middle and
after parts light winds and squalls
to end lat 38-42 N Long 68-19 W

Saturday
April 29th
1857
63

Commenced with light winds and
calm seas employed in ship's duties
At 4 PM. Star & fore tacking to S.W.
and the current &c. round but light
all the middle and after parts light
breeze lat 38-44 N Long 68-45 W

Sunday
April 30th
1857
64

Commenced with light breeze from
S.W. star & fore tacking in tacking
the head round 2 sails in sight &c.
All the middle and after parts light
breeze & calms to end lat 38-45 N Long 68-45 W

Monday
May 1st
1857
65

Commenced with calm and light
breeze from S. and S.W. and S.
Star & fore current 2 sails in sight
At 8 PM. fore & main tacked
and all the after part at 4 AM
fore & ship's tacking to the S.W.
to end lat 38-45 N

Tuesday
May 2nd
1857
66

Commenced with strong breeze from
S.W. star & fore tacking with
main top gallant sheeting sail out
just able to stem the current &c.
At 4 PM. fore & main tacked to the N.W.
Double reefed the foresail At 8 PM.
took them in and laid the ship
to continued a strong gale off
the middle and after part & fore
whale & fore tacking star
to end lat 39-45 N

Commenced with strong gales
and clear weather star & fore cold lay
To in at N.W. gale headed to N.E. & S.
At 8 PM. fore tacked star & fore
At 8 PM. made sail at the foresail
Spencer's fore tacks and main sail
Wind continued strong all the time
The after part at 11 AM. became
Equally again &c. to end lat 39-50 N

Thursday
May 4th
1857
68

Commenced with strong wind from
N.W. star to the S.W. under S. Reg.
Foresails & mainsail and spencers &c.
Star & fore off the fore quarter star
to the S. At 4 PM. fore & main tacked
Middle part fore tacked and S. & fore
Duck at 4 PM. fore tacked off tacked
to the S.W. & end lat 40-00 N Long 68-45 W

Friday
May 5th
1857
69

Commenced with strong winds
from S. star S.W. at 4 PM.
Foresails to the S.W. & S. All the
middle and after part moderate weather
to end lat 40-05 N Longitude 68-45 W

Saturday
May 6th
1857
70

Commenced with moderate weather
and fine breeze from N.W. star to the
N.W. fore tacked at 8 PM. took
the same to the S. in S. fore tacked
all the middle and after part thick
and foggy at intervals At 10 AM. fore
The fore works overboard At 11 PM. fore
At bottom to end lat 42-27 N Long 68-45 W

Sunday
May 7th
1857
71

Commenced with light winds from
S.W. star & fore tacked at intervals
At 4 PM. fore tacked at the fore tacked
& fore tacked at 8 PM. fore tacked
fore tacked and tacked ship at 12 PM. fore tacked
fore tacked at 11 AM. fore tacked and fore tacked
A schooner from Cape Cod bound to S. banks
had no cable fore & S. fore tacked
Rembered vessels tacking different way to
End lat 42-27 N Long 68-45 W
