

Thursday May 18th Lat 36.17
Long 78.34

This day comes with light S.W. wind and foggy atmosphere at 5 o'clock P.M. school of whales close to but could not see them as it was thick fog. Middle part comes with calm and thick fog. Latter part fresh breeze from same quarter set mainsail and crew to the eastward.

Friday May 19th Lat 36.45
Long 73.25

This day comes with pleasant weather with moderate wind from S.W. but still very hazy saw two large whales and one finback. at dark took in mainsail. Middle part calm. Latter part fresh to moderate S.W. winds.

Saturday May 20th Lat
Long

This day comes with good breeze from Westward but still very hazy. Saw plenty porpoise Grampus & Finbacks. Middle part calm. Latter part all sail set working eastward.

Sunday May 21st Lat 38.55
Long 72.34

This comes with good whaling breeze but no whales. Middle part very light air from the West saw two shears and several finback Grampus cowfish and. Latter part nice weather at 10 A.M. raised large whale. turned out to be a school of sperm whales going into S.E. towed for them and all three boats got fast. Ends with boat working on whales at noon got third water whale alongside.

Monday May 22nd Lat 36.57
Long 72.03

This day comes with calm at 7 P.M. got the other two whales alongside and it then shut in thick fog. Middle part the same. Latter part cut in the whales and started the work and sent down the gear.

Tuesday May 23rd

This day commences with pleasant weather and light S.W. air. Middle part the same. Latter part two whales in sight chasing whales we lowered but did not get fast. Ends with boat chasing.

Wednesday May 24th Lat
Long

This day commences with pleasant weather and very light wind from S.W. At sunset boat got up chasing and came aboard. Latter part the same two whales in sight and chasing whales. Two lowered and got fast. Ends with flat calm and boat coming aboard with the whales.

Thursday May 25th Lat 37.22
Long 72.06
This day commences with calm at 10 P.M. got the two whales alongside and started to milk at 6.30 finish. Middle part crew employed cleaning up the hull and stowing down the oil. Latter part started the work. Ends boiling One Whale in sight.
