Long

This day comes with strong breeze from
S.W. and very hazy at dark weather
very moderate with wind from same quarter
Crew employed boiling and running up tanks.
Ende killing two whales in sight

Saturday May 27th Lat
Long

This day comes with pleasant weather
finished Boiling stowed down the oil
and weather began to look quite bad
at dark strong S.W. wind Middle
and latter part fresh gale from same quarter
one whale in sight

Sunday May 28th Lat
Long

This day comes with strong wind from
S.W. Middle part the same latter
part moderate weather with wind from same
quarter

Monday May 29th Lat 37.20
Long 73.00

This day comes with pleasant weather
and moderate weather with wind from
same quarter as preceding day until midnight
after day for the first time in three days.
Latter part weather quite moderate but the
atmosphere still hazy

Tuesday May 30th Lat 36.58
Long 73.01

This day comes with light easterly air Middle
and latter part the same spoke like Ellen Adair
she has not seen anything lately

Wednesday May 31st

Lat 36.52
Long 72.51

This day comes with calm Middle part the same
but three whaling boats in sight all the calmed
Latter part light easterly air

Thursday June 1st Lat 36.40
Long 72.48

This day comes with very light easterly air
Dammed John Towner she having taken
200 lbs this season at 5.30 raised a school
of sperm whales lowered in company with
the Towner but did not get fast as they were
running quick into the southern Middle
part whales alongside going into the north
Latter part light easterly weather five
whales in sight

Friday June 2nd Lat 37.10
Long 72.40

This day comes with trifling wind from
the West with a little rain at dark
spoke John A. M. Nicholson with 700 lbs of bone
and 15 lbs of sperm from whales in sight one
boiling Middle part very moderate latter
part good breeze from E. all sail set
standing Eastward bound for Western ground

Sat June 3rd Lat 36.47
Long 71.13

This day comes with pleasant weather
and moderate wind from E. Middle part
did not calm latter part light breeze
from West all sail set standing easterly
steering about E by S. from whaling boats
in sight saw plenty of porpoise got one
