

Sunday June 4th Lat 36.47
Long 69.31

This day comes with light wind from W.N.W. all sail set during E by S. Saw steamer bound into the V.C. Middle part very light air from same quarter. Latter part took a squall from N.E. stormed in sail and day ends with calm.

Monday June 5th Lat
Long

This day comes with calm. Middle part the same. Latter part men employed setting up rigging but one man in none refusing to obey the mate's orders. This day ends with light southerly air all sail set during E.S.E.

Tuesday June 6th Lat
Long

This day comes with moderate breeze from S.W. at dark strong wind from same quarter. Middle part blowing fresh took in sail and lay to the eastward with easy sail. Latter part blowing fresh Gale from S.W. with a very heavy sea running. Ends with sails laying under two by sails and reef fore stay sail seen astern.

Wednesday June 7th Lat 36.02
Long 65.15

This day comes with fresh gale from S.W. at dark weather a little better but still a heavy sea running from East S. East. Middle part the same. Latter part comes with fresh S.W. wind and heavy swell running from S.E. & E.

Thursday June 8th Lat 36.00
Long 63.42

This day comes with fresh S.W. by S. and heavy swell running from the East. Middle part squally weather from the same quarter with some rain. Set Main sail and gaff top sail. Course S.E. by E.

Friday June 9th Lat 34.50
Long 60.13

This day comes with fair weather and fresh S.W. wind. Course S.E. by E. all sail set still quite a heavy swell running from the Eastward. Middle & latter part good weather with fresh wind from same quarter.

Saturday June 10th Lat 34.50
Long 56.14

This day comes with fresh to strong S.W. wind. Middle part took in jib. Top sail and gaff top sail. Latter part took in main and jib. Course E.N.E. going along under by sail fore sail and fore lay sail.

Sunday June 11th Lat 33.28
Long 53.29

This day comes with fresh S.W. wind at dark took in fore sail and set fore by sail and hove to into the Southerly. Middle and latter part very pleasant weather but still fresh breeze from S.W.
