At dark Capt Edwards of the *Whiskie* and Capt Lewis of the *John R. Manista* came aboard they having taken about 200 lbs this season.

Middle part crew employed running up the junk and at 9 P.M. started the works. At daylight finished running up the junk.

Latter part calm crew employed running up the Blubber.

Wednesday June 21stLat
Long

This day comes with pleasant weather and calm Middle & latter part the same. Crew employed running up the blubber stowing down oil and pumping out water.

Thursday June 22ndLat
Long

This day comes with very pleasant weather. Crew employed trying out oil. Middle and latter part good breeze from S.W. side with freshing breeze from same quarter.

Friday June 23rdLat
Long

This day comes with strong wind from S.W. finished stowing down oil and cleaned up deck. Middle and latter part strong S.W. wind and heavy sea running accompanied with some rain.

Saturday June 24thLat
Long

This day comes with strong S.W. wind and heavy swell running. Middle part very much better part fine weather with light breeze from S.W. Put the star board over the stern and put the new boat on the larboard cranes also fired the waist boat.

Sunday June 25thLat 3140
Long 4720

This day comes with very pleasant weather and moderate S.W. wind. No cruising under short sail. Middle part weather the same. Latter part calm. Crew employed doing odd jobs around deck.

Monday June 26thLat 3208
Long 4710

This day comes with calm Middle and latter part weather the same. Crew employed slushing down mast and doing odd jobs around decks.

Tuesday June 27th

This day comes with calm plenty of dolphins around saw porpoise and a king fish. Middle part little light air from East. Latter part calm. Broke out flour beans and Beef.

Wednesday June 28thLat 3240
Long 4715

This comes with light air from East all sail set standing into the North. Whales seem to be very scarce around these diggings. At dark took in sail. Middle part calm. Latter light air from S.E. plenty of porpoise dolphins ship jacks blackfish.
