This day comes with pleasant weather and light breeze from S.E. Saw Grampus porpoise caught some dolphins and at 3.30 raised a large whale going into the sea. Towed for him and Mate struck at 6.45 P.M. At dark whale sporting thick body and at 8 P.M. got the whale alongside and at the weather. Latter part commenced cutting at 4.30 got the head off and at noon got the body in. Ends with very pleasant weather.

Friday June 30th

This day comes with very pleasant weather started to cut in the head got the junk in on deck and started to bail the case and at 6 P.M. finished and sent down the gear and started the work. Middle and latter part crew employed working on the oil.

Saturday July 1st

This day comes with light air from S.E. crew employed running up the blecker boiling and stowing down some of the Middle part calm.

Two whale

Latter part light air from S.E. by S at 10.45 raised a lone whale going into N.W.E. Ends with whale all ready to lower. Saw a carcass.

This day comes with light breeze from S.E. at 12.30 towed for the whale at 3.30 Mate struck and shortly afterwards got badly stove around mate struck and his line parted and the whale went off with three iron and four branks in him ahead him until dark and the boat crew aboard finished boiling turned up about 75 lbs

Middle part very pleasant weather and light air from S.E. Latter part showed down the oil and looking hard for the whale.

Monday July 3rd Lat Long

This day comes with pleasant weather finish showing down the oil and also up the ship. At dark wind hauled into S.W. with light squalls hanging around. Middle and latter part calm. Took the tarboard boat on deck to repair it.

Tuesday July 4th Lat Long

This day comes with calm Middle and latter part the same. Still working on the boat.

Wednesday July 5th Lat Long

This day comes with calm Middle part the same finished repairing the tarboard and put it on the cranes and also took the mast boat on deck to repair and paint it as it is leaking very bad. Latter part very light air from North.

Thursday July 6th Lat 33-03 Long 49-03

This day comes with light breeze from N.W. Two whales in sight a bark and a row. At dark put the Mast boat back on the cranes and named the John Pedro Peralla ship having taken 250 this season. Also found that our ship is about 70 miles out. Middle part weather the same. Latter part good breeze from N.W. three whales in sight. Saw porpoise.
