This day comes with light breeze from N.W.W. at 4 P.M. finished stowing down the oil. Bleared up the ship and after supper went aboard the scho. Carver she having taken 400 lbs this season

Sunday July 16thLat 33.27

This day comes with pleasant weather and moderate breeze from N.W. Middle and latter part strong from same quarter latter part one brig in sight.

Monday July 17thLat 33.13
Long 49.05

This day comes with fresh buffeting wind from N.W.W. Gammed Brig Viola she having taken 335 lbs this season at 3.30 sailed alone whale think she sho run over him toward for him but he went very quick into the North Middle part fresh wind from same quarter latter part strong breeze from N.W.W. One Brig and a barhen sight.

Tuesday July 18thLat
Long

This day comes with strong N.W.W. wind at dark took in the foresail and set for his ail. Middle part very rough latter part the same

Wednesday July 19thLat 33.11
Long 45.11

This day comes with fresh N.W.W. winds. Middle and latter part the same

Thursday July 20thLat 33.06
Long 45.04

This day comes with fresh squally weather with wind from N.W.W. At dark wind died out and the edd. part flat calm latter part got light air from S.E. all sail set cruising saw grampine and porpoise

Friday July 21stLat 33.20
Long 48.14

This day comes with very pleasant weather and moderate S.E. wind all sail set cruising. At dark very moderate took in main sail and headsails and run into the N.W.W. At daylight one whaling barke in sight saw several large white water shoof for them and latter on raised whaler spotting going quick into the west. We waited with the barke as we were afraid we would lose run of the whale & lowered all three boats and 2nd Make struck soon after wards the barke lowered four boats and they took five whales along side and we got three ends with boats still in the water.
