

Saturday July 22nd

This day comes with fresh S.W. wind
At 4 P.M. got the boat alongside and got
third mate
got
fourth mate
alongside
the head of Capt Sylvia of the bark Greyhound
came aboard and stayed a little while At
noon raised a humpback whale Ende
with very pleasant weather and light S.W. wind.

Sunday July 23rd

This day comes with very pleasant
weather and light air from S.W. pushed up
a dead whale sheet had two tubs of line
on it got him alongside and raised a school
of whales swimming quiet into the N.W. corner
for them and chased until sunset but did
not get fast. the bark also had two boats
down chasing Hiddle and latter parts
very light air from S.E.

Sunday July 24th Lat 33.33
Long 48.53

This day comes with very light air from
S.E. Capt from the Greyhound and the
Hypatia came aboard at dark they all went
aboard the Mystic at 8.30 woke up the
gun Latter part very fresh S.E. wind
finish boiling turned up about 5.7 the

Tuesday July 25th Lat
Long

This day comes with moderate weather
and wind from S.E. stowed down some
of the Oil and left the rest until the morning
Latter part stowed off the rest and left
off to the North

Wednesday 26th Lat 33.03
Long 48.40

This day comes with pleasant weather
with wind from E.S.E. At 1.30 P.M.
raised a large white whale and at 2 P.M.
raised four humpback whales sporting toward
for them and soon after the mole struck
one at dark got him alongside and
plucked him two whales in sight chasing
whales. Hiddle part calmer latter
part commenced cutting the whale
Ende cutting with a very choppy swell and
light S.E. wind.

Thursday July 27th Lat 33.28
Long 48.48

This day comes with moderate S.E.
wind finished cutting and commenced
boiling Hiddle part weather about the same
Latter part raised a humpback whale
she got one we lowered but did not get
any whale going very quick into the south.

Friday July 28th Lat 32.59
Long 48.52

This day comes with very light air
varying from S.E. to N.E. two whales in
sight one boiling Hiddle part finish boiling
commenced about 5.0 the Ende with calm and
squally weather and commenced
