

Saturday Sept 30thLat 34° 23'
Long 28° 14'

This day comes with pleasant weather accompanied with a hazy atmosphere saw two turtles At dark weather looking rainy with plenty of lightening into the S.W. wind about S by E coming in rain at night. Middle part very moderate At daylight set fore & Main & sails. Latter part ends with light E.S.E. air. Scho standing along by the wind heading about S 1/2 W.

Sunday Sept Oct 1stLat 32° 33'
Long 28° 04'Long 11th

This day comes with very light air from E.S.E. Scho standing along by the wind crew employed straightening out the fore and after masts. Middle part very moderate wind from S.E. At daylight weather looking rainy into the S.W. lashed ship into the East and set to the gaff topsails. Ends with very moderate air from S by South.

Monday Oct 2ndLat 32° 00'
Long 27° 32'

This day comes with very pleasant weather and light wind from S by E. Scho heading into the East on starboard tack ~~with~~ all sail. Middle part very light air from same quarter. Latter part comes with calm weather looking very rainy into the S.W. Later on got a squall from that quarter and some rain which left baffling wind from the southward Scho standing along on efficient tack.

Tuesday Oct 3rdLat 31° 55'
Long 26° 50'

This day comes with light baffling southerly wind weather looking rainy with heavy swell running from N.E. Middle part weather cleared up some Scho standing into the S.W. under lower sails plenty of ship fack around. Middle part the same. Latter part got plenty of rain from the S.E. Scho heading into the southward on Port Tack. Ends with very light air from about E.S.E. Went on for Topsail. Made boat mact for want boat.

Wednesday Oct 3rd

Lat 31° 10'

Log 25-30W

this day comes with moderate wind from E.S.E. all sail set Stung S by E. Course at dark good breeze about E. Middle and latter parts light N.E. wind with squalls and plenty rain Ends with very pleasant weather with wind about same.

Thursday Oct 4th Lat 30° 03' Log 25-50

This day begins with pleasant weather and light N.E. air course S by E. Middle part calm. Latter light baffling air from N.E. Turned the quarter boats, painted them and with calm.

Oct 5th P.O. Oct 5th

This day comes with light squall from N.E. and plenty of rain at dark wind came in from the S.W. running heavy.

Middle part still raining and night cleared up and got light breeze from N.W. E. Latter part back wind from N.E. called out the trade course S by E 1/2 E.

Saturday Oct 6th Lat 28° 20' Long 24° 50'
