Sunday Oct 29th Lat 7-27
Long 24-02

This day comes with calm
Middle and latter part calm weather looks very
rainy N. Obs mendel on new mainsail

Monday Oct 30th Lat 7-19

This day comes with light at sunset got
light wind from S. by E. Middle part squalls
with rain wind light from different quarter
Schr. working southward on different tacks
Latter part very light breeze from N.E. about
at a bug and Schr. in sight

Tuesday Oct 31 Lat 6-55
Long 25-33

This day comes with light S.E. breeze and
large swell from S.E. three whaling vessels in
sight. Bug viola Schr. Voltaire and Pedro vanilla
All sails set standing in to the southerly
Middle and latter part squally

Wednesday Nov 1st 1911 Lat 6-30 N
Long 23-50 W.

This day comes with light breeze picked up
a piece of Board and caught some bark spoke a

from Brava three whaling vessels in sight
Middle light breeze from S.E. Schr. standing in to the

Thursday Nov 2nd No Obs.

This day comes with nasty squally weather
at 2 P.m. got heavy squall from East ran
into the south until 430 then the wind
died out at dark Bug Viola in sight
Middle part some with light breeze from S.E.
weather looking very rainy Middle and latter part
got heavy squall from S.E. barried away yet hopes
stay have to and at day light cleared it away
weather the same rainy
