This day commences with very pleasant weather and moderate trades from S.E. two merchantmen in sight crew employed mending jib topsail and doing odd jobs around decks all sail set standing in to the S.W. on port tack Middle and latter part moderate at daylight retaking Brug Viola in sight way out ahead

Saturday Nov 11<sup>th</sup>Lat 35° N  
Long 19-04W

This day commences with moderate trades from S.E. W. at dark retaking Brug Viola astern we having overhauled her during the day. Middle and latter part very pleasant weather and moderate trades from S.E. crew employed doing odd jobs.

Sunday Nov 12<sup>th</sup> Lat 55° S.Long 30-21<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>W

This day comes with the fresh trades from S.E. by East. Schr. heading S. 1/2 W. under all lower sail at dark very moderate set topsails. Middle part and latter part fresh trades and mainsail wind about E.S.E. Course S. 1/2 E.

Monday Nov 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 2-35°

Long 29-38 1/2 W

This day comes with fresh trades from S.E. Schr heading S 1/2 E under all lower sail at dark set main topsail but soon took it in all so took in mainsail trades very strong

Tuesday Nov 14<sup>th</sup>Lat 3-41° S.

Long 29-51W

This day comes with moderate trades 1 P.M. took reef out of mainsail at dark very moderate Schr. heading S 1/2 E. Middle and latter part strong trades from S.E. by E. Saw Blackfish and porpoise and merchantman in sight <sup>from north</sup> made a new pore a jib parrel

Wednesday Nov 15<sup>th</sup>

Lat 5-34° S

Long 29-53 1/4 W

This comes with strong trades from the same quarter the Schr. heading S by E. Middle part very fresh trades from about S.E. by E. all ~~the~~ sail and topsail latter part the same saw finback and also saw a merchant Barque bound in to the South and with weather looking squally

Thursday Nov 16<sup>th</sup>

Lat 7-02° S

Long 29-52 1/2 W

This day comes with fresh squally trades from East but they soon hauled back into the S.E. quite fresh after supper weather clearing up same and not quite so fresh bent on jib topsail and set it Middle part pleasant weather to wards morning got a squall from East carried away the jib took in mainsail latter part crew employed bending on another jib another squally
