This day comes with strong trades from E.S.E. and very squally light rain crew employed setting up jib topsail stay and other odd jobs around deck at dark took in fore and main topsails and stood along under all lowered sail heading about S. 1/2 E. Middle and latter part very pleasant with fresh trades all sail set ship heading about S. by E 1/4 E. saw two finbacks

Saturday Nov 18th ^{Lat} 10-00 d.
Long 28-52 3/4 W

This day comes with very pleasant with fresh trades from about E.S.E. ship going along at good jog under all sail set heading S. by E 1/4 E. plenty of fish around caught a few. Middle and latter part the weather and wind the same. saw a steamer bound into the S.W.

Sun Sunday Nov 19th Lat 12-29
Long 28-03 1/2

This day comes with very pleasant weather and fresh trades from E.S.E. ship heading about S. by E. by the wind at 4 P.M. raised sprits stood for them but it turned out to be a finback all sail set Middle and latter part very pleasant weather with trades very moderate ship heading about S. by W 1/4 W. wind about S.E. we saw spout but could not make it out

Monday Nov 20th Lat 14-17 S.
Long 27-44 3/4 W.

This day comes with very moderate trades from about S. E. ship heading S. by W. 1/4 W. Middle and latter part weather the same saw a steamer bound into the S.W. turned over starboard the boat and passed it also made a house for the dog and filled up 2 cask with salt water

Tuesday Nov 21th Lat 15-57 S.
Long 27-03 1/2 W.

This day comes with very light trades from E.S.E. crew employed painted the starboard boat and filling two cask with salt water and doing other odd jobs around deck and aloft Middle and latter part weather the same

Wednesday Nov 22th No obs

This day comes with very pleasant weather and moderate trades varying from E.S.E. to E by North at dark very light trades from S.W. same wind in to the latter. Middle part very light air from E.S.E. latter part light trades from E by N. ship heading S.E. by E. on port tack

Thursday Nov 23th Lat 18-57 S.
Long 24-50 1/4 W.

This day comes with pleasant weather and very moderate trades from E.S.E. ship heading S.E. by E on port tack Middle and latter part fresh trades from same quarter
