

Friday Dec. 8thLat 23-21
Long 112-41 1/2

This day comes with very light air from about N.E. by E. Scher standing along our port bound the water to the sea of cam. Get more breeze at dark air very light from about East by South Scher close hauled heading N.E. 1/2 N. Saw Grampas and kill fish. Crew employed setting up the fore and main rigging Middle and later part the same all do standing on different tacks.

Saturday Dec. 9th Lat 22-54.5
Long 11-28. W.

This day comes with very moderate weather the Scher still heading in to the north on the starboard tack with very light air from about Easterly Middle and later part the weather the same still heading in to the S.E. on the port tack all sail set.

Sunday Dec. 10th Lat 23-43³
Long 10-22 1/2

This day comes with very good weather the Scher heading in to the S.E. wind about E.N. all sail set at 4 P.M. passed the whale bound. Souther stood for him lowered tow boats but could do nothing with it on account it was too late the Scher heading S.E. by the wind Middle and later part moderate weather and the same Scher heading on different tacks all sail set S.E.

Monday Dec. 11thLat 23-53.5
Long 9-23-3/4 W.

This day comes with moderate wind from about E.N. Scher standing on port tack E by S. all sail set at dark very light air but the Scher heading the same at middle night got calm we took in mainsail and up for and maintopsail.

Tuesday Dec. 12th Lat 23-55.5
Long 9-16. W.

This day comes with Northerly wind and very pleasant weather Scher stood a long on tow different tacks heading about E by S on with all sail set same grampas and poppers Middle part fresh breeze from East the Scher standing on port tack with all sail set heading E by N. later part the same. Saw a white water stood fore him but turned fin back.

Wednesday Dec. 13 Lat 23-16.5
Long 28-3/4

This day comes with fresh trade from about E.N. the Scher stood on starboard tack with all sail heading about S.E. by S. at dark took in the jib topsail and fore topsail Middle part the same later part we have squally and rain took in light sails but soon set it again. Saw a Grampas brechin and spouting.
