

Monday Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>Lat 17-40.5  
Long 10-18.6

This day commence with fresh Breeze from about S.E. by S. later on moderate weather the Scher standing on the Starboard tack heading S.E. by E. Saw a school Blackfish lowered two boats and we got tow at dark took in mainsail and got topsail and maintopsail and got the screw on them Middle part the same at day light the crew employed makin a little oil of Black fishs head later part fresh Breeze and little rough weather

Tuesday Jan. 9<sup>th</sup> Lat 17-48.5  
Long 11-14  $\frac{1}{4}$  E.

This day commence with fresh Breeze from a bout S.E. the Scher standing on Starboard tack under lower sail heading S.E. by E. at dark we spout her round and standing in to the westerly Middle and later part the same saw plenty diamond fish and weather is very thick can not see a good ways of

Wednesday Jan 9<sup>th</sup> Lat 19-25.5  
Long 10-26  $\frac{3}{4}$  E.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and light air from about S.W. at dark took in get and got topsail and the Scher standing on the port tack under lower sail Shepton 3 cask of fresh water and filled up with salt Middle part very pleasant weather latter part saw a Black fish we lowered the Boats and got 5. at 11-55 we got them a long light

Thursday Jan 10<sup>th</sup>Lat  
Long N. 0.5

This day commence with very pleasant weather and moderate westerly wind the Scher standing on the Starboard tack under lower sail the crew employed working on the Blackfish and tying the port on the Shear on the carter water and have two man on the Stays tying the port it on at dark the best part was done and start fier on leg work about 8-25 took in the mainsail and foresail and set maintopsail Middle part the same later part very moderat weather and southerly wind the Scher standing on Starboard tack heading N.E. course

Friday Jan 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 17-03.3  
Long 10-34 E.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and southerly wind the Scher heading N.E. course at dark took in mainsail and head sails set the maintopsail and got traw fixed the the get topsail Bout Stay Middle part the same later part saw two Whaling vessels and then we saw a School whalls we lowered the Boats and got tow

Saturday Jan 12<sup>th</sup> Lat 17-03.3  
Long 10-35  $\frac{1}{2}$  E.

This day commence with very moderat weather with the boats chasing whalls two vessels in sight and one Steamer at dark about 7-35 p.m. got tow whalls a long light took in Sails and set the whack the whalls working in to the N.N.W. and some bound S.W. Middle part the same at day light start catching \$720 all done working Blawtop and start free Boiling
