This day comence with moderat weather and light air from about W.S.W. we lifefite the fresh weather and filled up 3 cask of salt water Middle and later part the same

Wednesday Jan 17th

This day comence with light air from about S.W. at dark took in sail and set muntjesail and hawse too on the Starboard tack the Scher stand, heading S by W. Saw sponc but tinsout fimbah Middle and later part the weather the same and the crew employed down ~~the~~ got round the ark and Alcyon up the back get out ready for oil

Thursday Jan 18th

Lat 16-54.5

Long 10-33 $\frac{1}{2}$.E

This day comence with very pleasant weather and light air from about S.W. the Scher heading in to the Northerly and Easterly hunting for the whalls but we did not seen anything to day at dark took in the mainsail and had sails set muntjesail and hawse too on Starboard tack heading in to the S.E. Middle and later part the same

Friday Jan 19th

Lat 16-44.5

Long 10-32 $\frac{1}{2}$.E

This day comence with very pleasant weather and buffy air from S.W. the Scher standing on distant tacks hunting for whalls but we did not seen any thing but grampers and lots like Bussais a whalls at dark took in mainsail and fupsails and set muntjesail and standing on port tack heading in to the Easterly Middle and later part the same

Saturday Jan 20

This day comence with fresh breeze from about S.W. and saw three vessels Scher mistec and Scher Wiland and one Bark most be Grahamnd the captan have been aboard mistec couple hours at dark took in mainsail and get set the muntjesail and stood in to the Westerly on port tack Middle part the same at day light moderat weather and saw Pedro Wardla in sight latter on saw Scher mistec and Bark Grahamnd and upland but we have not seen any thing this day
