Long 10-58- $\frac{3}{4}$ E

This day comence with very moderat leads from about S.E. the Sch. Starving NE course with all sail set latter on diffiunt course about E by S. at dark took in mainsail and foresail. yet and jettopsail set fore and mantjesail Middle part the same at day light set mainsail and foresail and jettopsail the Sch. was heading ENE course and raised tow whalers in sight we spoke the Bark morningstar and Bark Grahound.

Sunday Jan. 28thLat 15-21^S
Long 10-34 W

This day comence with very moderate leads from about S.E. and very pleasant weather saw porpoise and two whaling vessels in sight. Bark morningstar and Bark Grahound and Sch. Valcarga. all have all sail set cruising round but it was nothing round but one fimbark and porpoise at dark in sail set the fore and mantjesail the Sch. stood in to the Eastward on the starboard tack. Middle part the same at day light set sail Starving NE. course at 930 raised island and two more whaling vessels in sight. one was Bk. morningstar and Grahound and Valcarga and we saw nothing but porpoise and dinner fish

Monday Jan. 29th Lat 14-50.5
Long 12-15 E

This day comence with very moderat weather and from about W. S.W. the Sch. standing by the wind on the diffiunt tack and getting this is the party day we have have round here it. at dark took in mainsail and mantjesail and yet and jettopsail set mantjesail the Sch. standing on starboard tack heading in to the Westward Middle part very moderat at day light set sail the Sch. bearing NE. by E. saw fimbark and Grampus and Sch. mistie in sight latter part spoke with mistie.

Tuesday Jan. 30thLat 15-40. S
Long 11-38 Dr.

This day comence with fresh westerly wind the Sch. stands cruising round with all sail set on diffiunt tack mated with Sch. mistie but did not see anything but porpoise and one fimbark at dark took in mainsail and yet and jettopsail and came too on port tack heading W. by N. Middle part moderat weather and wind from about S.W. at day light mak sail the Sch. heading W. by N. latter part saw whaling Sch. in sight

Wednesday Jan. 31thLat 15-38. S
Long 10-37 Dr

This day comence with fresh Breeze from about S.W. the Sch. standing on diffiunt tack cruising round but saw nothing but fimbark and porpoise and one whaling Sch. in sight. rode the island about 225 p.m. at dark took in sail. set fore and mantjesail and heave tow of shore. Middle part the same at day light set sail the Sch. stood in to the Westward by the wind saw fimbark and porpoise latter part the same saw fimbark and Grampus
