Long 11-08 Dr.

This day comence with very moderate weather and good breeze from about S.W. the Sch. stands by the wind with all sail set crossing round 1 on different tacks set dark lookin mansail and mantjesail and jib-top sail set mantjesail at this day the crew employed slushing the Spurge the Sch. heading into the S.W. Middle and latter part the same and we get sight of Pedro Varela.

Friday February 2ndLat 15-33 S
Long 11-07 Dr.

This day comence with very moderate weather and light air from S.W. Jammed with Pedro Varela she having seen nothing since we saw her last. very day on this coast bound off into nother we have from her 200 lbs Rice 7 chance for tree bags of flour at dark tookin sail and hoze tow under fored and mantjesail the Sch. heading in to the West. Middle and later part the same Pedro Varela in sight saw a rigger wather stood for ham but did not see him anymore 10 lbs. tobacco to Pedro Varela to be replaced in Dominik

Saturday Feb. 3rdLat 14-56 S
Long 11-07 1/2 Dr.

This day comence with very moderate weather and very light breeze from about S.W. the Sch. Crossing round with all sail set the crew employed shaffeting wather down from fored shalf. and foled up 2 cask of salt wather at dark took in sail and hoze tow under fored and mantjesail the Sch. heading S.E. by E. at 6.25 p.m. spoke Pedro but she have not seen anything at all day. Middle and latter part the same.

Sunday Feb. 4thLat
Long

This day comes with very moderate weather and wind from S.W. the Sch. headen different course crossing round into the N. and Eastward saw a rigger wather but turnout Giampess. tookin the jibtop sail on dark to fixed got side of Pedro Varela and Breeg Varela in sight at dark tookin mantjesail and mansail set mantjesail. the cooked daseses from the gally Middle and latter part the same saw Bush Graham and Pedro Varela and Breeg Varela in sight.

Monday Feb. 5thLat 14-08 S
Long 10-01 1/2 Dr.

This day comence with moderate weather wind from about S.W. the Sch. Stearing different course in to westerly with all sail set saw Blackfish at dark tookin mansail and topesail jib and jibtop sail. hoze tow on port tack. the Sch. heading W. by N. Middle part the same. at day light Pedro was in sight. we set jib and jibtop sail and foresail Stearing N.N.W. course latter part the same.

Tuesday Feb. 6thLat 13-50 S
Long 9-12

This day comence with very pleasant weather wind from S.W. the Sch. heading N.N.W. course with mantjesail the crew employed setting up the mantjes mastud again and at dark fashed and hoze tow on port tack the Sch. heading W. under mantjesail and foresail Middle part the same at day light started to fixed the foresail the Sch. heading different course into the N. and westerd latter part the same.
