

Wednesday Feb. 7th Lat 13-00. S
Long 8-53 $\frac{3}{4}$. E

this day comence with very pleasant weather and wind from about SW. the Sch. Steaming different courses into N. and W. at 4-45 P.M. raze the School whalls bound in to the Coast. we lowered trict Boats. at about 630 P.M. fast Boat but the line got packed by a mother whalls. at 8. o'clock the Boats got a long sight. and peaked up on crans. took in mainsail and jib and jibtopersail set montresail and heave tow on Starboard tack heading in to the S. E. Middle part very moderate weather and wind from W. S.W. later parte the work on the foresail is done

Thursday
Friday Feb. 8th Lat 13-09. S
Long 9-21 $\frac{1}{4}$. E.

this day comence with very pleasant weather and W. S.W. wind the Sch. Cruising round with all sail set on different courses Saw a Blackfish. stood for them. tow Boats but did not get anything at dark took in sail set fore and montresail and heave tow on Starboard tack heading into S. E. by S. Middle part the same day light calm later on Breeze up and saw plenty Blackfish and porpoises the crew employed working on the ~~fore~~ foresail

Friday Feb. 9th Lat 12-54 S
Long 8-49 $\frac{1}{4}$. E.

this day comence with very pleasant weather and light air from about SW the Sch. Cruising round with everything set on different tacks but could not raze anything but fimbak and Blackfish and porpoises at dark took in sail set fore and montresail and heave tow on port tack heading in to the westerly unmandet the one foresail mandet on the other one Middle and later part calm Saw Sperm and porpoises

Saturday Feb 10th Lat 13-05 S
Long 8-48. E.

this day comence with very light air from SW the Sch. heading NNE under light sails with very moderate weather at dark took in foresail and jib and jibtopersail the Sch. bearing NNE. courses at day light set mainsail and foresail the Sch. stands heading W. with S.W. wind on Beantuffed weather we were saw on this coast so far. Saw Spout but turn out fimbak later part the same but the Sch. stands on different tacks hunting for some whalls but nothing the ground so far.

Sunday Feb. 11th Lat 12-27 S
Long 8-33. E.

this day comence with very pleasant weather and S.W. wind the Sch. stands on different tacks by the wind at dark took in sail set the fore and montresail and heave tow on Starboard tack about S. by E. Middle and later part the same the Sch. standing a long with everything set heading into the westerly saw a lots Blackfish and porpoises and Sperm.
