

Monday Feb 12th Lat 12-15 S
Long 8-33 1/4 E.

this day comence with very moderate weather and light air from about S.W. by W. the Sch. Stung by the wind on different tacks saw plenty Blakfish and Tarpers later on saw a pond about 7 miles off and we thing it was a sperm whale but the Sch. could not head up to him. at dark took in mainsail and mantop sail and jib and jibtop sail set the fore topsail and wind died out calm the Sch. heading about South Middle night calm at day light squally rain and light air from S.E. latter part the crew employed working on the mainsail saw plenty Blakfish but did not lieg anything.

Tuesday Feb 13th No Obs

this day comence with calm the Sch. lased heading into the South but it was no wind at all. at dark set fore and mantop sail heading S.E. but calm just the same. this day we put all the boardage in to the two New cask and cut up the wold mainsail took out the cover for the foresail and mainsail Middle part calm at day light set the sail but it was no wind on count calm. so we blaked down again the crew employed working on the cover for the mainsail and foresail saw porpoise

Wednesday Feb 14th Lat 12-20 S
Long 7-55 1/4 E.

this day comence with calm the crew employed working on the sail cover at dark set fore and mantop sail the Sch. heading W. Middle part the same later part light from S.E. but did not calm

Thursday Feb 15th Lat 12-24 S
Long 7-26 3/4 E.

this day comence with very moderate weather and light wind from about S.W. the Sch. standing on Starboard tack heading about S. with all sail set the crew employed making the sail cover. at 11:15 P.M. saw Blakfish loured one boat down but did not get any. at dark took in mainsail and mantop sail and jibtop sail set mantop sail Middle part the same at day light very moderate weather and light wind from about S.W. the Sch. stood along by the wind on different tacks with everything set

Friday Feb 16th Lat 12-41 S
Long 7-34 3/4

this day comence with very pleasant weather and light wind from about S.W. the Sch. stood along with everything set heading S.E. by S. on the Starboard tack saw plenty porpoise the crew employed working on sail cover. at dark took in mainsail, mantop sail and jibtop sail set mantop sail the Sch. heading S.E. on the Starboard tack Middle night good breeze from S.W. by E. day light moderate set mainsail and jibtop sail the Sch. stood along by the wind on different tacks later part the same

Saturday Feb 17th Lat 13-15 S
Long 7-08 E.

this day comence with fresh trade from about S.E. the Sch. standing a long with all sail out on different tacks saw porpoise the cover for the sail all done. at dark took in mainsail and topsail and jibtop sail set the topsail the Sch. heading S.E. on Starboard tack Middle and later part the same
