Tuesday April 2th Lat 25-09^N

Middle part wind from the same quarter at day light saw a merchantman bound Southward. later part the same

Thursday April 4th Lat 5-09^N
Long 39-41^W

this day commence with very pleasant weather and N.E. trade the Sch. Steaming N.W. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. course with all sail set the crew employed working round deck and up loft. at dark the same Middle and later part the same

Friday April 5th Lat 6-43^N
Long 42-31^W

Scraped this day comes with very pleasant weather and the bound good breeze from about N.N.E. the Sch. Steaming N.W. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. course with all sail set the crew employed working on rigging and odds jobs a round deck at dark the same Middle night the same at day light moderate weather and trade from the same quarter the crew employed working on rigging and painting later part saw Steamer bound Southward and one vessel bound about N.E.

Saturday April 6th N. obs.

this day commence with very moderate weather and wind about N.N.E. the Sch. Steaming N.W. by W. course with all sail set and the crew employed painting and down adds jobs a round deck at dark the same Middle and later part fresh breeze from about N. by E. the Sch. Steaming N.W. by W. course the crew employed painting and set drapery the spars
