

Saturday April 13th

The vessel it is anchored in Barbados
the crew employed washing the vessel out
sight at 4 P.M. Some provisions came a Board
at day light the Cap. came a Board but he returned
a shore again. later part the same

Sunday April 14th

this day commence with very nice weather in the
harbor the vessel is already for sea at
5.42 P.M. we sailed from Barbados bound
Dominica the ship steering N.W. course
at dark the same Middle part the same
day light very light sea from about E.S.E.
and saw the eastern shore bound Southward
later part got sight of the island the ship
heading N.W. course with all sail set.

Monday April 15th Lat 14-30^N
Long 60-05.00^W

this day commence with very moderate weather
and wind from about E.S.E. the ship steering
N.W. course with all sail set and
island in sight Middle and later part the same

Tuesday 16th

very pleasant weather and wind from different
quarters at dark the same Middle part the
same later part about 10 o'clock we unhooked
in Dominica

Wednesday April 17th
started with the ship and hall a long
sight R.M. clock and started breaking out the
oil middle and later part the same have on
deck 25 cask of oil

Thursday April 18th
we have all the oil on Board of her and
get out and started stood down Middle and
later part the same and put on Board R.W. clock
25 cask of oil all the gather Board the R.W. clock
47th cask of oil contain 999 gallons of oil

Friday April 19th very pleasant
weather the crew employed down adds yobs
round Middle and later part the same

Saturday 20th April
very nice weather in the harbor the crew
employed working and get in ready for sea
Middle and later part painting the
ship Middle part plenty of rain later part
the same received from bark. Barth & sons the oil duty
and 6 hats

Sunday April 21st
this day commence with very nice weather in
the harbor the crew employed working to
get ready for sea Middle and later part
rain

Monday April 22nd
this day the crew employed getting the
mountain from the rear Middle and later
part the same
