Spoke her and she have not seen anything at
at dark the same Middle night & calm at day
light very light air from about E.S.E. later part
the same the Sch. came in sight

Thursday May 9th Lat 24-15 N
Long 62-58 1/2 W.

this day comence with very moderate weather and
very light S.E. trade wind the Sch. heading N.E.
course with all sail set the crew employed
down adds jobs around the deck at dark the
same Middle part the same later part trade
from the same quarter saw glimpse the
crew employed making New year a lutting pennant

Friday May 10th Lat 26-20 N
Long 62-11 1/4 W.

this day comence with fresh S.E. trade and
the Sch. steering N.E. course later on took in
mainsail and set mantresail the crew employed
down adds jobs around deck at dark the same
Middle part the same later part very light
air from about East we took in mainsail
to put on a new thong on upper garff

Saturday May 11th Lat 28-00 N

Long 62-08 W.
This day comence with calm the Sch. heading in
the Northward and saw a school of whales gain in to
the S.E. and put all three boats on water but
did not get anything the boats got a Board at
7 P.M. and have been down from about 4 30 10 A.M.
and we took in sail and have tow under
mantresail and fored Stasail heading in to the
Eastward Middle and later part calm saw two
Steamer bound Southward

Sunday May 12th Lat 28-34 N
Long 60-49 1/4 W.

This day comence with very flat calm the Sch.
heading anywhere. Middle part the same at dark part
quite fresh breeze from about N.E. the Sch. heading
N by W by the wind on the Starboard tack
at dark took in sail set fored and mantresail
and have tow on Starboard tack

Monday May 13th Lat 29-25 N
Long 60-45 1/4 W.

this day comence with fresh breeze from about
N.E. the Sch. stands on Starboard tack heading
N by the wind saw one Sch. and we think that
is Cameo: at dark the same we took in
mainsail and foresail set fored and mantresail
Middle and later part very moderate weather the
crew employed down adds jobs around deck doing
sails.
