Monday May 20 Lat 30-53. N.
Long 59-27 3/4 W.

this day comence with Calm we took in all the sail at dark the same Middle night the same day light very light air from Eastward we set sail but the wind didnot after all the Cruise employed Brakinout one cask flour uprid and takout 8 bags and poof in the sail pane later part the same

Tuesday May 21th Lat 30-27. N.
Long 59-44 1/4 W.

this day comence with very moderate weather and light air from about E. S. E. the Sch. Stands with all sail out headin in to Southward the Cruise employed down adds jobs around deck at dark the same took in mainsail and get topsail set mantigesail and hove tow Middle oright the same day light set sail and stood in to the Northly during by the wind later part the same saw one Steamer bound W.

Wednesday May 22th Lat 30-27. N.
Long 59-31 W.

This day comence with very pleasant weather and Easterly wind the Sch. Stands Starboard tack heading in to the N. E. by the wind at dark took in mainsail and get topsail set mantigesail and hove tow on Starboard tack heading N. E. Middle part the same day light very light air from S. E. and didnot calm later part took mantigesail on deck and sew it over saw tow Steamers bound West

Thursday May 23th Lat 30-30. N.
Long 59-26 1/4 W.

This day comence with very flat Calm we put all the sail on the boom and the Cruise employed down some sewing on the mantigesail at dark the same Middle and later part light wind from about E. N. E. the Sch. heading in to the S. and E. on different tack. the Cruise employed down some sewing on mantigesail
