

Wednesday May 29th No. 45.

This day comence with Squall and S.W. wind and rain very heavy took in sail set for and mantresail the Sch. stands on starboard tack heading in to southerly at dark no rain the wind is about S. the Sch. heading S.E. and 1 1/2 A.K. in sight Middle night rain pretty heavy later part set mainsail and standing long by the wind and the wind is about S. S.E.

Thursday May 30th Lat 31-17 N.
Long 52-23 3/4 W.

This day comence with fresh Breeze from about S. S.W. and some rain the Sch. stands on different tacks at 3 p.m. took in mainsail and set mantresail and hove two on starboard tack heading E. S.E. with Bark A.K. in sight Middle part the same later part very moderate weather and S.E. wind the Sch. standing with all sail set about E. by the wind Bark A.K. in sight

Friday May 31th Lat 31-25 N.
Long 52-16 3/4 W.

This day comence with very pleasant weather and wind from about S. S.E. the Sch. stands with all ~~all~~ set heading E. by S. during by the wind at dark took in foresail and mainsail set for and mantresail hove two heading E. saw two school papers Middle and later part the same

Saturday June 1st Lat 31-53 N.
Long 51-59 1/2 W.

This day comence with very pleasant weather and southerly wind the Sch. stands on the different tacks with all sail set saw papers at dark took in mainsail and topsails set for and mantresail and hove two the Sch. heading E. S.E. Middle and later part the same

Sunday June 2nd Lat 32-01 N.
Long 51-48 1/2 W.

This day comence with very pleasant weather and S.E. Breeze the Sch. stands on different tacks with everything set heading in to the S. and Easter the Bark A.K. Chasing Whales about 15 miles away from us but dont thing she gets any thing this day at dark took in mainsail and topsails set mantresail hove two on port tack heading South Middle and later part calm and the Bark A.K. in sight

Monday June 3rd Lat 31-31 N.
Long 52-12 1/2 W.

this day comence with calm and put all the sail on the boom on a count slathing two masts at dark very light air from S.E. set the foresail and jib but sooner we took it in the wind died out again Middle part the same at day light set mainsail and topsails the Sch. steering different course in to the southerly and Easter later part the same
