

Saturday June 8th Lat 30-05 N.
Long 52-14 1/2 W.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and North by wind the Schr. standing along with all sail set. Cruising round but nothing have seen this day. Saw Bark morning Star in sight the crew employed filled up 3 cask of salt water at dark took in mainsail and topsails set mantrysail and have two on starboard tack heading N.E. Middle part calm late part light air from about E.N.E. set mainsail the Schr. stands heading N.E. by the wind.

Sunday June 9th Lat 29-53 N.
Long 53-26 3/4 W.

This day commence with very light air from about E.N.E. the Schr. stands by the wind heading in to the East at 2 P.M. found the Bark morning Star and she have seen anything at all. and seen so the whalls is very scarce around we took the sealings out the starboard boat and paint it in sight and half light the boat stars at dark the same took in mainsail set mantrysail the Schr. stood in to the North by. Middle part the same day light set sail heading in to the East and saw Bark morning Star drop her boats down and we lowered three boats but we did not get anything and Boats from the morning star got two whalls.

Monday June 10th Lat 30-07 N.
Long 53-14 W.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and light air from about E.S.E. and all the boats chasing whalls but did not get any at 2 45 P.M. the boats got long sight and put them on Cronin at 5 P.M. raised the whalls again but did not lower on cont it was later the whalls was to far away at dark the Schr. stands with all sail set heading about N.E. by the wind Middle part the same at day light set sail and raised school whalls and lowered all three boats. Bark morning Star lowered 4 boats but she did not get any later part got the whal long sight.

Tuesday June 11th Lat 30-17 N.
Long 53-05 1/4 W.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and wind about W.S.W. the crew employed gathering and Bark morning Star in sight sailing at 3 55 got them gathering and set the whacks at 5 P.M. start work at dark took in mainsail and set mantrysail the Schr. heading in to the westerly Middle part rain at day light rough weather and S.W. wind later part the same but the crew employed working the Schr. have been on different tacks.
