this day comance with very pleasant weather and SW air the Sch. steering S.E. course saw three whaling vessels in sight the breeze implied down odds got around at dark took in mainsail and set and set topsail set mantresail and hove two on port tack heading N.W. pumps and lights attending Middle and later part the same

Saturday June 22th Lat 31-49 N.
Long 51-17 $\frac{3}{4}$ W.

this day comance with very pleasant weather and light air from about N.W. the Sch. have ben cruising round with all sail set but nothing seen this day and seem so the whalls is very scarce here at dark took in sail and hove two on starboard tack heading into the north pumps and lights attended Middle and later part the same and Sch. valary in sight

Sunday June 23th Lat 31-25 N.
Long 50-40 W.

this day comance with pleasant weather and light air from about S. and grounded the Sch. valary and she have about 150 B^{ls} of oil saw pumps at dark Calm took in mainsail and foresail pumps and lights attended Middle and later part the same saw valary in sight and other whaling vessels the Sch. stands with all sail sail set heading into the S. and E.
