

Saturday June 29th Lat 31-19 N
Long 49-55 1/4 W

This day commences with very pleasant weather and very light air from about S. the Scher heading into the North on a course westerly boats Chasing whalls but we did not get nearer at all at 4 P.M. boats got a long sight set on crew at dark took in sail and hoisted two under topsail and foresail heading to E and got three stowing all Middle and later part the same the crew employed down some sounding on jibtop sail

Sunday June 30th Lat 31-20 N
Long 49-25 3/4 W

This day commences with very moderate weather and light breeze from about S.W. the Scher steering into the East with all sail set and tow whalling Scher. in sight at 3.50 P.M. raised school whalls gain about S.W. but the boats did not get so near to them at dark the boats got a long sight with set squall rain took in mainsail and jibtop sail hoisted two heading S. by E. Middle night wind from the same quarter at day light made sail and zigzag round into N and E. tow whalling whalls in sight later part the same

Monday July 1th Lat 31-36 N
Long 49-32 3/4 W

This day commences with very pleasant weather and westerly wind the Scher crossing round with all sail set on different tack later at dark the same took in sail set for and mantjesail and hoisted two on Starboard tack heading into the South by pumps and lights attended Middle part the same at day light set sail and heading into the N. and Easterward later part wind from the quarter and crossing round on different tacks

Tuesday July 2th Lat 31-04 N
Long 49-29 W

This day commences with very pleasant weather and wind from about S.W. the Scher steering about N. and E. on different tacks at dark took in mainsail set mantjesail and hoisted two on Starboard tack heading about S. E. lights and pumps attended Middle part the same day light raised school whalls and put the boats on weather and got one at 3 P.M. got it along sight wind from the same quarter
