

Tuesday July 3rd

Lat 32-10 N.
Long 49-24 W.

this day commence with very pleasant weather and westerly wind at 3 P.M. got up all a long sight and start to catting at dark got it all in and send the gear down and took in mainsail and start rain later on calm and weather looks squally the Sch. heading W-SW. pumps and lights attended Middle part rain at day light set mainsail and started crossing round on different tack later part the same wind from the same quarter

Thursday July 4th Lat 32-17 N.
Long 49-41 W.

this day commence with squally weather and wind from about N.E. took in foresail start to work on blaker at dark took in mainsail and set mantjesail the Sch. heading into Easterwood Middle part the work is done at day light quiet rough weather and fresh breeze from about N.E. the Sch. stands into the E. and mantjesail the crew employed pumpin the gitan ready for the oil later part the same

Friday July 5th

Lat 32-04 N.
Long 49-58 W.

this day commence with fresh breeze from about E.N.E. and rough weather the Sch. stands under mantjesail heading into the N. and E. the crew standing the oil down and odds got a round dack at dark wind from the same quarter took in foresail and set set foresail pumps and lights attended Middle and later part calm and squally rain

Saturday July 6th No. 0's

this day comes with flat calm saw steamer bound into the west and the Sch. heading into the W. and southerly with something on boom on count the calm at dark the same pumps and lights attended Middle and later part calm and rain squalls saw grampuss

Sunday July 7th Lat 32-51 N.
Long 49-20 W.

this day commence with calm saw grampuss and one steamer bound into the W. the Sch. heading N.E. and we have the mainsail on tack downed on the deames on count the deames given out at dark the same pumps and lights attended Middle night the same day light very clear and rain squalls later part breeze from about N.E. set mainsail the Sch. standing by the wind heading into E. and soon did out saw grampuss and puppers
