

Friday July 12th Lat 34-18. N.
Long 49-41 W.

this day commence with very moderate weather and light air from about S.W. by S. the Sch. heading into the southerly the Cruise employed working on blake at dark took in mainsail dit mantresail: pumps and lights attended Middle night we got storm topped out at day light set sail and steering S.E. by S. course the Cruise employed sheffling weather to getting ready for oil later part the same saw steamer bound into the southerly

Saturday July 13th Lat 34-25 N
Long 48-26 W.

this day commence with very pleasant weather and light wind from about S.W. the Sch. steering S.E. course and the Cruise employed stowdown the oil Sch. Carlton Belle in sight at dark the same: took in mainsail and dit mantresail: the Sch. stood into the westerly but soon lost a calm Middle night the same at day light wind from the same quarter the Sch. Carlton Belle in sight later part the same

Sunday July 14th Lat 34-11 N.
Long 48-40 W.

this day commence with calm the Cruise employed stowing the oil down: saw grampers and porpoise at dark all done and we slak down the sails on count the calm: the Sch. Carlton Belle in sight Middle night the same at day light very light air from about S.W. set mainsail and topsails the Sch. steering different course into the S. and Easter: later part the same: Sch. Carlton Belle in sight

Monday July 15th Lat 33-54 N
Long 48-48 W.

this day commence with very moderate weather and light air from about S.W. the Sch. heading into the S. and Easter at dark took in mainsail and topsails. dit the mantresail and did out Calm: pumps and lights attended Middle night the same at day light set sail and the Sch. steering different course into the S. and W. later part the same

Tuesday July 16th Lat 33-44 N
Long 48-53 W.

this day commence with very pleasant weather and westerly wind the Sch. heading S.W. at dark calm took in mainsail and dit mantresail pumps and lights attended saw steamer bound into the Easter Middle and later part the same saw grampers and porpoise
